### **Hospitality Business and Tourism Keystone Course**

[3 credits]—This introductory course acquaints students with hospitality business and tourism in Japan. Classroom study will be augmented with a variety of site visits and guest lectures from professionals in the field.

### **Introduction to Japanese Language and Culture**

[3 credits]—This beginning-level Japanese course will introduce students to Japanese language and culture. Beyond classroom training, students will participate in field trips, demonstrations, homestays and other activities that complement their language study.

### **Hospitality Business and Tourism Internship**

[2-4 credits] Students will participate in an internship based on their interests to gain practical real-life experience in hotels, restaurants, tourism offices and related hospitality industries in Japan.

# HOUSING

Students will live in the JCMU apartments during the first portion of the program. The JCMU student apartments are designed for double occupancy. Each apartment consists of two private bedrooms/studies and a shared kitchen, dining area and bathroom. The residential building also includes a computer lab, wireless internet, laundry room, TV room, weight room and lounge. During the internship portion of the program, students will live in a homestay or on-site at the internship location, allowing them to experience day-to-day life with a Japanese family or Japanese colleagues.



## PROGRAM DETAILS

**Dates:** Early May to mid-June. Visit the JCMU website for exact dates.

**Requirements:** No prior Japanese language study is required. Students in various hospitality business and tourism related fields and majors are encouraged to apply.

**Costs:** Program and Housing Fee - \$5,700 (includes tuition, housing, books and health insurance).
