# AUSTRALIA

## BOND UNIVERSITY

(16 credits)

Earn a full semester of credit from early May to late August at Bond University, located on Queensland's Gold Coast. Bond offers hundreds of course options and an integrated learning environment where you will be in class with Australian and other international students. You can earn up to 16 credits by taking courses in business, psychology, communications, law, international relations, Australian studies, information technology and a full spectrum of other subject areas. In addition to your studies, you'll have the opportunity to experience Australian culture by living on the Gold Coast, within easy reach of the beach, the Glasshouse Mountains, and Brisbane, the third largest city in Australia.

## ARCADIA SYDNEY SUMMER INTERNSHIP

(6 credits)

Picture yourself working in Sydney, Australia, one of the world's most exciting cities. With its magnificent harbor, oceanside beaches, modern skyscrapers, and multi-cultural population, you'll quickly understand why Sydney is such a popular destination for students from around the world. You can earn academic credit, enhance your professional knowledge, and improve your practical skills through a quality placement in one of Sydney's leading public institutions or commercial enterprises. Our experienced internship coordinators can arrange for you to work side-by-side with Australian professionals in such areas as business; social sciences; humanities; and the visual, fine, and graphic arts. You'll gain valuable experience that will help you prepare for entry into an increasingly global job market. What's more, you will live in an urban neighborhood of Sydney and have a chance to take part in the exciting, diverse, international energy of the city. Students spend three days per week at the internship site and one day participating in a keystone course designed to provide a cultural context for the internship experience. # INDIA

## Summer Seminar and Internship Experience in India (9 credits)

The Alliance's Summer Seminar and Internship Experience in India allows students to spend two months in India through structured seminar-lecture courses and a six-week internship with an Indian company, non-governmental organization, or other organization, or in an apprentice relationship with individuals in academia, policy, the performing arts, visual arts, or other media. The program, based in Pune, in Maharashtra, is designed to address two sets of student needs. The seminars offer students basic knowledge of Indian history, society, and political economy, and provide a space to discuss their learning and experiences while in India. The internship seeks to address the growing demand by students who study in India for practical experiences, especially within the fields of business, film and media, development, global health, and information technology, while maintaining options for students interested in the "traditional" aims of study abroad programs to India, those subjects within the realm of language, religion, history, culture, anthropology, and sociology.



# CHINA THE ALLIANCE FOR GLOBAL EDUCATION

All Alliance summer programs are eight weeks in length, with seven weeks of instruction. Students enjoy a five-day field study trip during the middle of the term. Trip destinations will be announced before the term begins.

## CHINA IN THE 21ST CENTURY LANGUAGE AND CULTURAL STUDIES IN BEIJING (8 credits)

Hosted by the Beijing Language and Culture University, Beijing.

This eight-week program provides students 12 class hours per week of Chinese language study as well as the opportunity to examine modern China through selecting a course in English from among several disciplines. Beijing Language and Culture University offers course instruction in Chinese language at all levels and courses on contemporary China, taught in English. All students are required to complete a capstone project, which encourages you to delve more deeply into a particular aspect of Chinese culture and society.

## INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS IN CHINA (8 credits)

Hosted by the Shanghai University of Finance and Economics, Shanghai.

Designed for students interested in international business and economics, this 8-week program offers undergraduates the unparalleled opportunity to study Chinese language, international business, and economic development in one of Asia's financial centers. Chinese language courses are taught at the beginning through advanced levels.

## CONTEMPORARY CHINESE SOCIETY AND LANGUAGE (8 credits)

Hosted by Fudan University, Shanghai.

Students will combine language study with an additional course taught in English, covering topics such as Chinese politics, culture, and economic development. All students are required to complete a capstone project, which encourages you to delve more deeply into a particular aspect of Chinese culture and society.

## INTENSIVE CHINESE LANGUAGE (8 CREDITS)

Hosted by Fudan University, Shanghai.

This track offers an intensive language program for students who wish to focus on learning Chinese. In the summer term, students take 20 class hours per week of Chinese language, allowing them to focus on language acquisition. Students in the Intensive Language Track must have completed two semesters, or the equivalent, of college-level Chinese language study.

## XI'AN: ART, HISTORY, AND THE SILK ROAD (8 credits)

Hosted by Xi'an International Studies University

This program gives students the opportunity to examine China through course (taught in English) in areas such as art history, culture, and sociology. All students study Chinese language as well, at this university that leads such education in the northwest region of China.



## ENGLAND

### LONDON SUMMER INTERNSHIP

(6 credits)

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 1**

Now is your chance to gain professional experience in one of the world's most vibrant and multi-cultural world capitals. The Arcadia London Summer Internship will provide you with unparalleled opportunities to become fully immersed in the professional and cultural life of London while working in such fields as the arts, business, communications, public policy, or the social sciences. You'll spend three days per week for six weeks in a job placement, expanding on what you have learned in the classroom. Combine this with an academic project and the experience of living in the heart of London and you are bound to have a rewarding academic and cultural experience that will significantly enhance your qualifications in any line of future endeavors.

### CONTEMPORARY BRITISH STUDIES IN LONDON

(3 or 6 credits)

This program will give you every opportunity to soak up London's rich culture and earn academic credit at the same time! You'll take one or two courses in British art, theater, literature, and politics with other American students. Our experienced British instructors take advantage of teaching in the heart of London by using local museums, theaters, and historical sites to enhance their lectures. Your classroom experience will come to life as you live and study in the very heart of this vibrant city.

### UNIVERSITY OF CAMBRIDGE

(9 credits)

#### Summer Program

If you're looking to experience the intellectual rigor and unique academic approach enjoyed by Cambridge undergraduates during the academic year, the Cambridge University Summer program, based at Pembroke and King's Colleges at Cambridge, is the right program for you. Over eight weeks, qualified students will take three courses, each of which is taught through a lecture/seminar program. Some courses are concentrated into four weeks, while others run for eight weeks. You can expect to earn nine semester hours of credit. Students will be able to choose from a wide range of courses including world literature, history, philosophy, economics, film, art history, behavioral ecology, and much more. All courses are taught by British faculty and are "Cambridge" in style, content and standard.

## FRANCE

### INTENSIVE FRENCH AND POLITICS, PARIS (6 credits)

Improve your proficiency in the French language while learning about French and European government. This advanced four-week interdisciplinary program is based in the incomparably romantic and charming city of Paris! Combining the world-famous language methods of the Alliance Française with the intensive classroom teaching and field research methods of the American Graduate School of International Relations & Diplomacy (AGSIRD), this summer program offers undergraduate students an approach to learning that is both rigorous and fun.

Students at all levels of French are welcome to apply. You will spend the morning taking classes in intensive French language with students from around the world. The afternoon will be devoted to seminars, experiential opportunities, and field excursions, which take advantage of the school's special Paris location and are designed to provide you with an intellectual understanding of French and European institutions.

## IRELAND

### CONTEMPORARY IRISH STUDIES IN DUBLIN

(6 credits)

Afford yourself a dose of Irish culture this summer and earn credit while doing it! You'll embark on a fascinating exploration of modern Irish literature, politics, and history as you study in Dublin, Ireland's dynamic capital city. Over the course of six weeks, participants will take Modern Irish Literature and Irish History and Politics. Of course, Ireland is a lot more than Dublin, and you'll participate in several study-related excursions, which will offer you an opportunity to explore Ireland beyond its capital city. The abundance of cultural and historical attractions promises to enliven your studies and your time spent discovering this energetic, colorful country.

### IRISH STUDIES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LIMERICK

(3 credits)

The College of Humanities at the University of Limerick offers students the unique opportunity to choose between five dynamic and enjoyable summer courses, all designed to introduce students to the history, culture, and politics of Ireland, while providing opportunities to experience contemporary life on the Emerald Isle through field excursions and other cultural events and programs. Each course runs for three weeks and students choose one of five concurrent sessions: Irish Life and Literature; Sociological Perspectives on Irish Society; Visual Culture in Ireland 1400-1950; Screening Ireland: Ireland in Film and Television; and Law in Ireland.

## GREECE

### **IN THE GAZE OF SAINTS: A Journey Through Medieval Greece**

**(3 credits)**

This course offers a rich introduction to the history of the Byzantine society and culture (330-1453), including direct encounters with its remaining monuments. We will examine the legacy of Constantine the Great and his Holy Empire. You will climb the rock monasteries of Meteora, explore the Byzantine ghost town of Mystras, and stroll through the cobbled lanes of the great maritime medieval city of Monemvasia!

### **OF GODS AND THE CITY: History, Art, and Architecture in Archaic and Classical Greece**

**(3 credits)**

During this three-week course based in Athens, you'll participate in field-study excursions and visit prominent archaeological remains including the Pan-Hellenic sanctuaries at Olympia, Delphi, Isthmia, and Nemea; the city sites of Corinth, Sparta, and Messene; and the battle sites of Marathon and Thermopylai. You'll feel a palpable connection to ancient Greece as our expert instructor guides you through the remains of ancient battle sites, cities, and sanctuaries.

### **ON THE TRAIL OF ALEXANDER THE GREAT... Greek History, Art and Architecture of the Hellenistic Age**

**(3 credits)**

Here's your chance to develop a clearer understanding of one of history's most enigmatic and mysterious figures. Your studies will begin in Athens, and then take you to Greek Macedonia, the island of Samos, and the Aegean coast, as you delve into the life and times of Alexander the Great and his contemporaries. You'll visit relevant monuments and museums as well as learn about Hellenistic civilization.

### **THE MAGNIFICENT MOSAIC: A Study of Contemporary Greece**

**(3 credits)**

This three-week, interdisciplinary course will help you understand the complex and sometimes contradictory mosaic that is contemporary Greece. A series of field visits in and out of Athens will encompass trips to sites as various as markets, monasteries, and monuments, both ancient and modern. Carefully selected readings that underscore the present-day concerns of Greek life will shed additional light on your time and experiences outside the classroom.

### **3 CITIES SUMMER SPECIAL MEDITERRANEAN MYTHS AND MONUMENTS:**

#### **The Classical World Today**

**(10 credits)**

The greatness of Greece, the glory of Rome, and all the splendor of Sicily! This nine-week, ten-credit program is an exciting journey through three cities and many centuries of antiquity! Students participate in the Athens summer program "Of Gods and the City," travel to Rome for a three-day study of the eternal city, and spend the remaining weeks in Syracuse, Italy, on the island of Sicily, studying various aspects of the classics and Mediterranean. A one-credit journaling class, taken throughout the program draws together the academic and field components that make this exclusive program opportunity a unique learning experience.

Consider registering for more than one consecutive, three week course. Students may opt to take one, two, or all three courses. Each is worth 3 credits and the cost per course is significantly less when you enroll in more than one course.

### **3 CITIES SUMMER SPECIAL MEDITERRANEAN MYTHS AND MONUMENTS: The Classical World Today** (10 credits)

The greatness of Greece, the glory of Rome, and all the splendor of Sicily! This nine-week, ten-credit program is an exciting journey through three cities and many centuries of antiquity! Students participate in the Athens summer program “Of Gods and the City,” travel to Rome for a three-day study of the eternal city, and spend the remaining weeks in Syracuse, Italy, on the island of Sicily, studying various aspects of the classics and Mediterranean. A one-credit journaling class, taken throughout the program draws together the academic and field components that make this exclusive program opportunity a unique learning experience.

## **ITALY**

### **INTENSIVE FASHION DESIGN IN FLORENCE**

**(6 credits)**

Discover the practical aspects of the fashion design profession. You will be based at the Accademia Italiana, one of Europe’s leading centers for art and design. You will develop your individual style in the production of articles of clothing, and finally, in designing a clothing collection.

### **DESIGN IN ITALY, FLORENCE**

**(6 credits)**

This program, based at the Accademia Italiana, a leading center for art and design, will aim to introduce students to the theoretical and practical aspects of Italian design. You will also try your hand at designing a piece of furniture, or a furnishing accessory.

### **ITALIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN FLORENCE**

**(3-4 or 6-7 credits)**

Based at the Accademia Italiana, right in the midst of the city’s Renaissance splendor, the program features courses in design, studio art, and Italian language. Most courses do not require prior study of the Italian language.

### **ITALIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN LECCE**

**(6 credits)**

Arcadia has collaborated with the Università del Salento to create a unique program in the Italian south that caters to the needs and interests of serious Italian students. Classes combine intensive language with an array of afternoon activities focusing on traditional, regional art forms. Sessions are offered in June, July and August. Students may choose to study during one of the three months or register for back-to-back sessions.

### **GENERAL STUDIES PROGRAM: ITALIAN CULTURE IN PERUGIA**

**(3-4 credits or 6-8 credits)**

The Umbra Institute is located in a beautiful, hilltop city in the heartland of Italy. You don’t need to speak Italian to enroll, but are sure to improve your proficiency as you explore the city, interact with its residents, and learn firsthand about Italian history and culture.

### **INTENSIVE ITALIAN CULTURE IN PERUGIA**

**(8 credits)**

The intensive immersion program at the Università per Stranieri di Perugia offers students an intensive, full-immersion Italian language and culture experience studying either Italian language exclusively or courses covering various topics in Italian language, literature, art, history, and culture, depending on your level of proficiency.

### **ITALIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN ROME**

**(3 or 6 credits)**

Accademia Italiana’s Summer Program in Rome offers courses in Italian language, archeology, film, and studio art. You’ll have the option of taking one course for three credits or two courses for six credits. All courses are taught by Italian faculty in the heart of the Eternal City.

### **INTENSIVE LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN SYRACUSE**

**(7-8 credits)**

The Mediterranean Center for Arts & Sciences (MCAS) offers a wide range of liberal arts courses which, combined with academic fieldtrips (included in the program fee and an integral part of the program in Sicily), enable students to explore the diversity of the Mediterranean world.



## SCOTLAND

### SCOTTISH UNIVERSITIES INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOLS (SUISS) (3 or 6 credits)

Do you have a penchant for creative writing or an interest in British literature? Imagine working with and listening to accomplished British writers and scholars, while enjoying the cultural and historical riches of Edinburgh, Scotland's beautiful capital city. The well-established SUISS program offers three brief, intensive, three-credit courses in three-week's duration each. Students may take one for a three-week (three-credit) experience or two for a six-week (six-credit) experience.

### CREATIVE WRITING IN SCOTLAND (3 credits)

Whether you are interested in fiction, poetry, drama, children's writing, or writing for the screen, you can sharpen your skills in this Creative Writing course through workshops and seminars. Being part of a group of aspiring writers from around the world will be sure to ignite your creative potential. The timing of the course will also allow you to participate in the world-famous Edinburgh International Book Festival.

### LITERATURE IN SCOTLAND

(3 credits)

If you have a love for literature and an interest in things British, this program is for you. Two distinct courses are available: one focusing on British Literature from 1900-1945 and the other British Literature from 1945-present. The courses provide a tremendous opportunity to hear leading novelists, poets, literary critics, and historians discuss the social, historical, and theoretical influences that have shaped modern British literature. Student learning is enhanced by mixing with other students from around the world who are interested in similar topics. An exciting menu of extracurricular activities will enhance your enjoyment of Edinburgh and Scotland, rounding out the academic experience.

*Note: Students can choose to take just one of the three courses, or can start with British Literature 1900-45 and stay on to take either Creative Writing or British Literature 1945-present.*

### THE UNIVERSITY OF STIRLING Summer Academic Program

(6-12 credits)

Looking for an integrated summer program that offers a wide range of courses in a picturesque UK setting? In the charming town of Stirling, in Central Scotland, this university-based program permits you to choose a four- or eight-week course of study, and give you a full spectrum of choice in subject areas, including environmental policy, business and management, politics, religion, philosophy, history, sports studies, international relations, creative writing, English, and film and media studies. In addition to the classroom experience, you'll be living on the campus of the University of Stirling, in close proximity to the Scottish Highlands and the magnificent Loch Lomond.

## SOUTH AFRICA

### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN CAPE TOWN (6 credits)

Arcadia has teamed up with SHAWCO (Students’ Health and Welfare Centres Organisation), an organization founded and governed by the students of the University of Cape Town. The program offers study abroad students a chance to contribute to communities in need, develop leadership skills, and earn credit at the same time.

Students spend the first two weeks of the six-week program teaching computer skills to adult learners, with the balance of time devoted to providing tutorial support for local middle-school students in academic subjects. In addition to this service-learning activity, students register for a core course taught by lecturers from the Department of Sociology at the University of Cape Town. The course consists of a series of seminars in which students develop insight into issues surrounding development, poverty, and power, as well as an understanding of economic development in post-apartheid South Africa. You will also attend weekly reflective sessions in which you will discuss your field work, learn skills to support your teaching, and relate your experiences to the overall themes of the core course.

### A DECADE OF DEMOCRACY AND BEYOND – Summer Study in Stellenbosch

University of Stellenbosch,  
Stellenbosch/Cape Town, South Africa  
(6 credits)

Learn first-hand about the history and politics of South Africa – from the end of apartheid through the first free election of Nelson Mandela, to the rise of South Africa’s stature in the global arena. Your studies will be based on the beautiful campus of the University of Stellenbosch, surrounded by the Cape Winelands and within 45 minutes of Cape Town. In addition to courses on the politics, history, and economics of this fascinating and important country, you may choose to take a course in biodiversity, explore African art and literature, or participate in a service learning project.

The program consists of lectures, group discussions, and field excursions and is taught by expert faculty from the University of Stellenbosch and top universities across the globe. The program draws students and faculty from around the world, injecting an international flavor and enhancing the learning experience for all participants.



## SPAIN

### SUMMER ARCADIA IN BARCELONA (8 credits)

Your studies will be based at The Arcadia Center for Catalan, Spanish & Mediterranean Studies, located in the bustling neighborhood of l'Eixample. This program consists of two required courses that focus on writing, photography, language, and culture, taking advantage of the rich heritage and history of the region of Catalonia.

### SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN GRANADA (6-12 credits)

The Arcadia program is based at the University of Granada's Centro de Lenguas Modernas, renowned for its programs in Hispanic Studies and in Spanish Language and Culture. Students at all levels of Spanish can be accommodated in Granada and you can choose to focus on Spanish language, or combine language study with a variety of courses related to Spanish literature, art, history, and business.

### SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE IN TOLEDO (6-9 credits)

Choose courses in Spanish language, culture, and history, while studying in a magnificent 16th-century, historical building in the heart of Toledo, a finely preserved, medieval city that sits less than one hour south of Madrid. You'll take two to three courses, all taught in Spanish. To increase your exposure to Spain and its language, there are even homestay and internship options available.

### SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN TOLEDO (6-9 credits)

Arcadia University, in conjunction with the Fundación José Ortega y Gasset in Toledo, is pleased to offer a flexible, combined work and course study option. Internship placements are available in many areas. Students combine 15 to 30 per week of on-site work with three or six credits covering various topics related to working in Spain and the European Union.
