Beware of Unaccredited Courses!

Certificates from unaccredited programs do not carry the same weight as those that are recognized on an international level. Be sure that the course you attend is accredited by an officially recognized accrediting agency.

The TEFL/TESOL Course

ESL teaching is an increasingly competitive field where having the right TEFL/TESOL training and certification makes a significant difference in terms of how you are viewed as a teaching professional. As well, the number of ESL career paths is increasing, ranging from ESL Teacher, University Lecturer, ESP Teacher, Director of Studies, Language Center Manager, etc. Therefore, having the right credentials is correspondingly important.

4-Week/150-Hour Certification Course

The onsite certification program is designed for people who want a professional, accredited certification to teach English anywhere in the world. The 4-week/150-hour program includes 100 hours of classroom instruction and 25 hours of practical teaching and observation and an additional 25 hours of required self-study and research outside of the classroom.

The onsite course is characterized by extremely high academic content and also includes an excellent practical teaching component. The overall aim of the course is to provide you with a professional graduate-level TESOL/TEFL course, including a balance between the theory and methodology of ESL. Certification

Upon completion of the TEFL/TESOL Certification program, graduates receive the Máximo Level TEFL/TESOL Certificate. Accelerated-Hybrid TEFL/TESOL Certification Program

The Accelerated-Hybrid program combines components from the onsite and online programs. Participants self-study the first half of the course with a tutor via email and 7 hours of included tutoring via Skype, then they join the onsite certification program for the final 2 weeks including the methodology modules and the practical teaching module. The Accelerated-Hybrid program is best for people who aren't able to attend the full 4-week program. The online/distance modules are generally completed in 1-3 months based on how program participants pace themselves.

TEFL/TESOL Certification Program—Online/Distance Option

This is NOT your ordinary online TEFL program! All other online TEFL/TESOL courses simply concentrate on ESL theory, which means you miss the interaction with your TEFL trainer and the all important practical teaching component. However, with Máximo Nivel's online/distance option, not only do you get all the theory, but you get to discuss and talk about it with your trainer via 15 hours of included tutoring via Skype. And most importantly, you teach six 1-hour lessons with a live English student.

Housing Options

The Family House

The Family House bed and breakfast offers accommodations similar to a traditional family-stay, but with more independence and privacy. Volunteers stay in shared rooms with one, two, or three other volunteers. Your stay includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner Monday through Sunday. Guests are given a key to their room and to the house and are free to come and go as they please. Laundry services are available for a small extra fee. The Family House is within walking distance (15-30 minutes) from Máximo Nivel's offices.

Traditional Family-Stay

Family-stays are all with pre-approved families and include breakfast and dinner Monday through Sunday. All of our host families are middle-class and live in homes and areas that are attractive. Most family-stays include a shared room and shared bath. Many of the families have been hosting international travelers for years. Guests are given a key to the house and are free to come and go as they please, but they must respect the routine and rules of the family. All family-stays are within walking distance (10-30 minutes) or within a 5-15 minute bus or taxi ride from Máximo Nivel's offices.

Private Apartment

Our private apartments are all modern, very comfortable, and fully furnished. Apartments come with equipped kitchens including plates and utensils required to live comfortably and cook for yourself. All apartments are centrally located and are within easy walking distance or a short taxi ride to the Máximo Nivel's offices.

Shared Apartment

How will I be assessed?

Participants in the TEFL/TESOL course are continually assessed. There are no written examinations, but there are 2 required academic papers and a professional portfolio. Class attendance is **required**. Final assessment is based on the following:

What pass rate do you have?

Even though it is an intensive and challenging course, the majority of our participants (around 95%) pass the TEFL/TESOL course. Overall, 60% are awarded a grade of **Pass/Good**, 5% receive a grade of **Pass/Excellent**, and 30% receive a grade of **Pass/Satisfactory**.

Does the TEFL/TESOL Certificate qualify me to teach English?

Yes. Your training will give you a major advantage over untrained teachers because you have declared your commitment to the field and to being a professional ESL teacher. Whether you want to work in South America, Central America, Asia, Europe, the Middle East, or anywhere else in the world, Máximo Level's TEFL/TESOL Certification will open doors to rewarding employment opportunities.

Are there really teaching jobs?

Yes, there are. The whole world wants to learn English. People everywhere, especially young people, are convinced that speaking English is their passport to a successful career. Worldwide, there are many more ESL jobs than there are native-speaking ESL teachers to fill them. Native English-speaking teachers are in high demand in every part of the world.

English teaching jobs can be found in every country and in virtually every region of the world – South America, Central America, Asia, Eastern/Central Europe, and Western Europe. There is also strong demand for professional instructors in English-speaking countries such as the U.S., UK, Australia, New Zealand, and South Africa.

Can I be considered for a teaching position with Máximo Level?

Yes. Máximo Level is a rapidly growing organization and we give preference to the top-performing participants in our TEFL/TESOL Certification program for employment at our executive language centers in Peru, Costa Rica, and Guatemala. Every month we make between 3-7 employment offers to our TEFL/TESOL graduates.

Can I make a real career out of TEFL/TESOL?

Yes. There are many opportunities for long-term permanent positions and even for advancement to Director of Studies and other administrative and executive positions. Other possibilities are teacher training and materials and curriculum development.

Is it necessary to speak a foreign language?

Máximo Level does NOT require a second language to study for the TEFL/TESOL Certification, or to teach English at our executive language center. And most other employers do not require you to speak any other language other than English. That said, some experience learning and speaking a foreign language will help you understand language in general and how people learn it.

Are there any age limits for TEFL/TESOL training?

You must be at least 18 years old to study for the TEFL/TESOL Certification at Máximo Level. You must be at least 21 years old to teach at Máximo Level. Generally speaking, ESL teachers range in age from 18 to 80, although it is more difficult to find employment if you are under 21 and over 50. Preferred age depends very much on the country, the culture, the school, and the type of students the school has; and legal requirements may also play a part. Some schools prefer more mature teachers, especially if their students are primarily business people. Others feel that younger teachers are more "dynamic" and "modern" in their approach. While still other countries are so desperate for teachers that age is irrelevant. Also, some countries will not issue a work visa for teachers over 45 years of age. The above all said, do not let the question of age put you off. With the Máximo Level TEFL/TESOL Certificate, you will undoubtedly find employment.

What if English is not my native language?

Máximo Level DOES permit non-native English speakers to enter the TEFL/TESOL course. However, you must provide proof of proficiency in English (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS, Michigan exams) and pass an oral interview before being accepted on to the course.

As well, Máximo Level offers a special weekend TEFL/TESOL Certification program for non-native English speakers. This course is 3 hours on Saturday and 3 hours on Sunday, and the course lasts 5 months – Please contact us for start dates.

Generally speaking, if you have a good TEFL/TESOL certificate, not being a native speaker should not be a major problem. However, non-native speakers may not be accepted in some countries - for example Korea requires that your passport be from a native English-speaking country. But in many other countries, your English fluency and TEFL/TESOL certification will be welcome additions to the teaching staff.

How quickly can I get the TEFL/TESOL certificate?

The Máximo Level TEFL/TESOL Certification program is 4 weeks long (150 total hours). Your certificate is awarded to you immediately following the course.

Note: There are many TEFL/TESOL courses offered online. Whereas there is undoubtedly value in the online courses, and you can receive your certificate in as little as 40 hours, employers will consider your certificate *far less seriously*. You should recognize that an important component of any serious TEFL/TESOL course is teaching practice with real students. That is why Máximo Level requires all of our TEFL/TESOL program participants to observe and teach a minimum of 25 hours prior to being certified.

Do I need a university degree?

Máximo Level does not require a college degree to enter our TEFL/TESOL Certification program. In most countries, the most important qualification is the TEFL/TESOL certificate itself. However, you might find some resistance by employers if you do not have at least a 2-year college degree. As well, especially in Asia and the Middle East, a work permit will not be granted if you do not have at least a bachelors degree. That said, with a TEFL/TESOL certificate, it is certainly possible to find work without a university degree, especially in South America and other developing regions.

Can my family come with me?

Máximo Level is happy to welcome you and your entire family to Peru, Costa Rica, and/or Guatemala. While you study, your family can study Spanish or enjoy tours and sightseeing. We are also happy to arrange special accommodations for families.

Do I have to get a work permit and residence visa?

Depending on where you are from you may or may not need a special visa. Most people, including those from the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and Europe, automatically receive a 90-day tourist visa when entering Costa Rica and Guatemala, and receive up to 183 days when entering Peru.

To work legally in a foreign country you need a work permit, with which you can then get a resident visa. That said, it is common practice for ESL teachers to work illegally in many parts of the world. Máximo Level's executive team will help you understand and navigate all the ins-and-outs and considerations in terms of work visas.

What about medical insurance?

Before you travel make sure that you are covered by medical insurance in case of accidents or emergencies. There are a number of companies specializing in international travel insurance. International Student Insurance is one such company, and can be contacted via their website www.internationalstudentinsurance.com. **Note:** Máximo Level is in no way affiliated with International Student Insurance, nor do we receive commissions of any kind.

What Should I Bring?

The key to packing for a trip to Peru is to pack for a variety of conditions. The best way to deal with the extremes that Peru has to offer – the intense sun during the day, the cold mountain nights, and the heat and humidity of the Amazon Basin – is to dress using several layers.

The key to packing for Costa Rica and Guatemala is to prepare for a warm and sometimes humid climate. The coastal areas are steamy and hot with lots of sunshine; and San Jose and La Antigua are warm by day and cool by night with intermittent sunshine and rain.

How much extra money should I bring?

Extra money depends on your personal spending habits. You will likely want extra money for personal expenses, sight-seeing, souvenirs, etc. Generally speaking, we recommend bringing about \$ 250.00 (USD) per week, or just bring your credit card. Note, travelers checks in Peru, Costa Rica, and Guatemala tend to be problematic to use and are NOT recommended.

The best method for getting money is to simply use ATMs. Most banks in Latin America offer 24-hour ATM access.

Do I need a Visa to enter Peru, Costa Rica, and Guatemala?

Depending on where you are from you may or may not need a special visa. Most people, including those from the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and Europe, automatically receive a 90-day tourist visa when entering Costa Rica and Guatemala, and receive up to 183 days when entering Peru.

Will I have phone and Internet access?

Máximo Nivel's offices have international phone and fax service. As well, our clients and students have free access to our computer centers with high speed internet and WiFi connections; and all the computers run Windows and Microsoft Office. Access to our offices and Internet facilities are available 7 days a week.

What should I do in case of an emergency?

Is the water safe to drink?

Tap water in Peru and Guatemala is NOT safe for drinking, but water straight from the tap in Costa Rica IS safe to drink. Tap water can be purified by boiling it or adding purification tablets, such as *Micropur*, which can be purchased at most pharmacies. Generally speaking, bottled water is easy to buy in stores. Showering and brushing your teeth with water is rarely a problem.

Do I need vaccinations?

It is recommended that travelers to Peru, Costa Rica, and Guatemala have vaccinations for Hepatitis A and Tetanus. Typhoid and Yellow Fever are sometimes recommended, but are not necessary. Malaria is not a threat in Peru, Costa Rica, or Guatemala. Other immunizations may be necessary depending upon the circumstances of your project and personal medical history. You should visit a travel-health clinic or your physician at least four weeks before traveling.

Should I bring any medicine?

It is recommended that you bring medications for travelers' diarrhea. The best way to prevent traveler's diarrhea is to be careful of the food and water that you eat and drink. *Ciprofloxacin* (Cipro) or *Levofloxacin* (Levaquin) are good choices for treatment of traveler's diarrhea.

In Peru, *Acetazolamide* is the drug most often used to prevent altitude sickness. The usual dosage is 125 milligrams or 250 milligrams two or three times daily starting 24 hours before ascent, and continuing for 48 hours after reaching altitude.

See your physician for specific recommendations.

Are Peru, Costa Rica, and Guatemala safe countries?

Yes, and you can relax while you are here.

That said, it's still important to use common sense.

- Be careful if traveling on buses, as petty theft is common.
- Ask for a receipt when you store your backpack or luggage.
- Do NOT carry your passport or any credit cards and cash that you will not need.
- Use only registered taxis.
- Do not walk into unknown areas by yourself at night.
- Avoid any contact with drugs, as laws are very strict.
