Shopping: Although tourists frequent the Gucci, Prada and Ferragamo stores, the outdoor markets have excellent deals on unique items.

Food: Due to the international environment, Florence has an eclectic choice of food, from Middle Eastern kebabs to Chinese take-out. But don't miss out on the traditional panini, pasta, pizza, gelato, and Tuscan specialties *ribolitta* and *bistecca alla Fiorentina*.

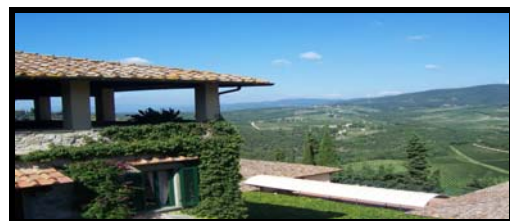
Length: 4 weeks, Mon-Fri, 120+ hours
