Requirements & Dates

Introduction

We offer world youth and teens an opportunity to study Chinese and experience China in the summer. The programs are from two to four weeks with intensive Chinese language lessons in the morning and cultural activities/events in the afternoon. The local trips are in the weekends or afternoons to let the students experience the cities and surroundings.

We have Beijing and Beijing-Shanghai programs for students to choose from. The Beijing-Shanghai program is Beijing based program with a 3-day Shanghai trip, but we can arrange airport transfers at either Beijing or Shanghai. Please see the program schedule for details.

We understand that safety is important to our students. The accommodations are located on campus. All our program site staffs are trained for safety issues. and we have 24 hour on-site coordinators with the students. Homestay in Beijing is available to those students who wants an intense immersion experience.

Courses, Trips & Activities

Trips

Trips are on weekends or afternoons:

Beijing program:

Forbidden City & Tian'anmen Square, the Great Wall & Ming Tomb, Temple of Heaven, the Summer Palace, Lama Temple, Beijing Old Streets, Hutong & Beihai, Wangfujing, Beijing Zoo, etc.

Shanghai 3-day Trip:

Shanghai Museum, Pujiang River Cruise, Yuyuan Garden, the Bund, and Suzhou etc.

(subject to change)

Activities

For all programs: Culture seminars, Martial Arts, Sports/Games, Chinese Calligraphy & Painting, Paper Cutting, Tea Ceremony, etc. Cultural activities & events are in the afternoon.

Exchange with Chinese students gives students opportunities to make Chinese friends and improve the language.

Classes

Classes are Monday to Friday 20 classes per week.

The language classes are held in the morning on campus from 8:00am to 11:40am. Each class is 45 minutes.

Students are separated into different levels according to their language levels. The language classes are conducted by state qualified teachers from the university.

Travel

The travel expenses from your home to China is not covered under the program fee, (The Beijing-Shanghai program covers round trip air tickets between Beijing-Shanghai. To make your travel easier, Travel agency information is available for students from North America.



Accommodation & Fees

Accommodation

We strive to provide a clean, safe and comfort accommodation to our students, and we received positive feedback about their stay.

On Campus Premium Dormitory:

Double Room: Shared accommodation on campus, TV, telephone, air-conditioner, washroom and linen services. Most students choose double dorm.

Single Room: Accommodation can be upgraded to a single dormitory for a surcharge. This provides some privacy at an additional cost.

Homestay in Beijing:

Our host families are carefully selected and interviewed, they are very nice and are very interested in exchange the local culture and language with our students.

Fees

The program fee includes: Tuition Text-books, Accommodation, Meals, Health Insurance, Trips, Activities, Airport Pickup and Drop Off.

We make all efforts to make our program fee affordable. The updated program fee is posted on our program website.

Financial aids

We do not have financial aid available. We also try to make the program fee affordable.

You could use your financial aid from your home school toward our program. Please check your financial aid office at your school for requirements. Once you are approved, we will sign the consortium agreement.



Schedule: Beijing

Locations

The program is hosted at Beijing Jiaotong University campus at Haidian District in Beijing.

The university is a state key university, and its campus is at convenient location with easy access to public transportation for shopping, downtown and tourist attractions.

School credits

We can provide course description and certificate (upon successfully finishing the program) for you to apply for school credit, your academic advisor at your home institute makes the final determination of whether you are eligible and how many credits you will get. As the certificate is issued by the university in China, the credit is often transferable. Please consult your academic advisor about your home institute's policy and process.

Requirements

Minimum age: 14 by the start date.

Our participants are mainly high school and university students. The students come from various countries around the world, from US, Canada and some European countries, such as Spain, France, so this is a great way to make friends from all over the world.

Application Process

- 1 Submit your online registration or mail the registration form, and pay the USD 85 registration fee.
- 2 Within 3 business days of receiving your registration, we will process it and send you the enrolment package.

- 4 Book your flight and apply for visa.
- 5 Pay the rest of program fee by the deadline. (The program fee is refundable, please read the program refund policy.)
