PROCESS

Application Process

1. Read these instructions and the terms and conditions found on our website carefully:
www.teachingchile.com/to_apply_terms
2. Complete the application package, which includes:
 - a. A completed application form (with signature)
 - b. Typewritten responses (essay style) to questions included in the application form
 - c. Photocopy of the page of your passport that contains your photograph and personal data
 - d. Copy of your résumé or C.V. (curriculum vitae)
 - e. Copy of your TEFL / TESOL or other teaching certificate(s) (only if you have one; not all teaching positions require certification, but are recommended)
 - f. Two references (including name, phone number and email).
 - g. Two passport sized-photographs with your passport number written on the reverse side
 - h. A U.S. \$50 non-refundable application fee (click on the link below for instructions)

3. Make a photocopy of all of the above for your records (including a photocopy of your \$50 check, if paying by check)

PROCESS

Placement Process

1. Once your application package has been received, TeachingChile will contact you to confirm receipt. Some teaching institutions may contact you for an interview.
2. Depending on the date you send your application and the review date of the teaching institution, there is a period of time you should plan to wait for a response. The teaching institution is the final decision maker and TeachingChile cannot control the institute's review and hire schedule.

While there are some exceptions, *in general*, historically the teaching institutions' application review schedule has been as follows:

- a) For February/March arrivals, the application review schedule is typically between mid September and mid January
 - b) For July/August arrivals, the application review schedule is typically between mid April and the end of May
3. Accepted applicants will be notified by email of their acceptance within two to four weeks of the review by the Teaching Institution. If you accept the job contract offered by the Teaching Institution, a 40% deposit toward the program placement fee will be due to TeachingChile. This deposit reserves the teaching position exclusively for you, thus blocking other applicants from receiving an offer for that particular teaching position. For this reason, the deposit is non-refundable.
 4. Upon your acceptance of the job offer, TeachingChile will send you a pre-departure and arrival package via email which will include visa application and processing instructions, details for your arrival and first night's lodging, and more.
 5. Approximately ten weeks prior to your departure, the final 60% payment toward the program placement fee (non-refundable) is due.
 6. TeachingChile will arrange a pre-paid transfer from Santiago airport to your first night's lodging, notifying you by email with all of the details. However, if you arrive into Chile before the date that we've suggested for attending the scheduled in-country orientation and training (perhaps because you are arriving early to take Spanish classes or tour South America), you will be responsible to get the airport transfer to your first night's lodging on your own.

PAYMENT METHODS

There are three methods to make a payment:

- mailing a check,
- faxing your credit card information and authorization, or
- paying using your PayPal account

RESUME / C.V. & ESSAY QUESTIONS

Develop a resume / curriculum vitae specifically for teaching in Chile. Try to limit the information to one page, being as concise as possible. Be sure to include the following information:

- Name, address, contact information (including day and evening phone numbers and email)
- Education
- Special certifications such as teacher's license or TEFL/TESOL (or intentions to complete a TEFL/TESOL course prior to your program placement date. Note: TEFL/TESOL certification is not required for all positions)
- Volunteer and/or community service experience (if applicable)
- Teaching experience (if applicable)
- Time spent abroad (study abroad, work abroad, leisure travel abroad, etc.)
- Professional skills
- Foreign language skills
- Other skills which you believe are relevant to this position
- Two references (including name, phone number and email address). You do not need to provide reference letters—only reference contact information.

ESSAY QUESTIONS

Please answer the following six questions. **IMPORTANT:** Given that your application may be photocopied and/or faxed we *highly* recommend you use Microsoft Word, a font type such as ARIEL, and font size 11. Please preface each answer with the question. Use essay format, 250 words or more per question.

1. Why do you believe you are a good candidate to offer English education in Chile?
2. What personal goals are you hoping to achieve as a teacher in a Chilean school?
3. What perceptions do you have of Chile: the people, the culture, the school system, etc.?
4. How do you feel you will adapt to living and working in a developing country? Give examples of how you have adapted to different lifestyles and circumstances?
5. What is your idea of a good English lesson?
6. What would you do if you feel some of your students are not really interested in English and do not cooperate in your class?
