Study & Intern in Madrid



Semesters offered: Fall, Spring Semesters Only

Internship fields: Politics & Law: Humanitarian & Relief Organizations; International Agencies; Law Firms; Non-Governmental Agencies; **Business:** Dance Companies; Fashion; Hotels; Marketing; **Arts:** Art Galleries; Dance Companies; **Sciences:** Biology/Physiology; Pharmacy; Computer Science and other internships by request if available. All internships are unpaid. Fall and Spring students work three or four days at their internship while taking two classes. Spanish working hours include a long midday break, and therefore students can anticipate a shorter work day.

Academic courses: Students take courses in Spanish one or two days per week at the **Universidad Antonio de Nebrija**, located in Northern Madrid.

Language requirement: Students must have taken four semesters of college-level Spanish or the equivalent and have a demonstrated proficiency in both spoken and written Spanish.

Housing: Students normally live in a rented section of family homes (a private bedroom) where bathroom and/or kitchen facilities may be shared with other students or the owners. Staying in private homes may include breakfast and one main meal per day. Independent flats are also available. Local staff will make living arrangements for the students prior to their arrival.

Credit: Upon successful completion, eight credits are awarded for the internship, and four credits for each course.

What's included in EPA fees: Comprehensive orientation, housing, two academic courses (none during the summer), internship placement with ongoing local support, and 24/7 local emergency contact.

Passport/Visa: A valid passport and Spanish Visa are required to participate.
