Study & Intern in Brussels

Semesters offered: Spring, Summer and Fall.
Summer internships in the European Parliament subject to availability.

Internship fields: **Politics & Law:** European Parliament, U.S. Mission to the E.U., Lobbying Organizations; **Business:** Banking/Finance Companies, Business Associations; **Communications:** PR/Marketing Firms; Industry Associations; **Health:** Health Ed & Advocacy; **Media:** (French Fluency Required) Museums, Radio/TV, Journalism; **Non-Profit Organizations:** Humanitarian Aid & Peace Organizations, Community Service/Outreach Programs. All internships are unpaid. Fall and Spring students work three or four days at their internship while taking two classes. Summer internships are full-time, and students do not take classes.

Academic courses: Courses are taught in English at **Vesalius College**, an English-speaking college on the campus of the Vrije Universiteit Brussel.

Language Requirement: All classes and most internships are in English. Additional languages are desirable within the EU Parliament. French is required for museum and media internships. If applying for an internship in a language other than English, four semesters of college-level language or the equivalent is required. Basic French skills are helpful but not required for daily living.

Housing: Most students live in dormitory-style apartments. Occasionally students live in rented sections of family homes where students have a private bedroom and bathroom & kitchen facilities may be shared. Local staff arrange housing for students prior to their arrival.

Credit: Upon successful completion, eight credits are awarded for the internship and four credits for each course. Summer internships are full-time, and students do not take classes.

What's included in EPA fees: Comprehensive orientation, housing, two academic courses during the Spring & Fall terms, internship placement, ongoing local support, two or three dinners/events, 24/7 local emergency contact.

Passport/Visa: A valid passport and Belgian Student Visa are required to participate. If over 21, you must submit an FBI background check.
