Study & Intern in Edinburgh



Semesters offered: Fall, Spring and Summer

Internship fields: **Politics & Law:** Scottish Parliament; Political Headquarters; Non-Governmental Organizations; **Business:** Advertising/PR; Finance; Forensic Accounting & Insolvency; Conference & Event Planning; Publishing; Tourism; **Health:** Medical and Biological Research; Health Ed. & Advocacy; **Arts:** Dance/Dance Therapy; Museums/Galleries; Scottish Studies; Theatre; **Education:** Primary Schools; Music Schools; Special Needs Schools and other internships by request if available. All internships are unpaid. Students divide their time equally between their coursework and their internship placement. In the summer students take one course in addition to their internship.

Academic courses: Students take courses at **Edinburgh Napier University** and have the use of university facilities, including the library, student union, etc.

Housing: Students are normally housed in an apartment ("flat" in Britain) with other students from the program. Local staff will make living arrangements for the students prior to their arrival. The apartments are fully furnished and most have broadband internet access.

Credit: Upon successful completion, eight credits are awarded for the internship, and four credits for each course. A total of eight credits is awarded for the summer program.

What's included in EPA fees: Comprehensive orientation, rent and utilities, two academic courses (one during the summer), internship placement with ongoing local support, and 24/7 local emergency contact.

Passport/Visa: A valid passport and UK Tier 4 Student Visa are required to participate. An FBI background check is needed for parliament, health science, education, and museum placements.
