Study & Intern in London

Semesters offered: Fall, Spring, and Summer

Internship fields: **Political Science/Law:** House of Commons; Law Firms; Lobbies/Pressure Groups; Non-Governmental Agencies; **Business:** Advertising/PR/Marketing; Banking; Journalism; **Health:** Health Education & Advocacy; Medical Research; Psychology Research; **Arts:** Museums; Art Galleries; Publishing; Theatre; **Education:** Primary Schools and other internships by request if available. All internships are unpaid. Students divide their time equally between their coursework and their internship placement. In the summer students take one course in addition to their internship.

Academic courses: Fall and Spring students choose 2 academic courses from over 700 offered at the **University of Westminster**. The course subjects reflect the main internship areas as well as cultural electives.

Housing: Students are normally housed in an apartment ("flat" in Britain) with other students from the program. Local staff will make living arrangements for the students prior to their arrival. The apartments are fully furnished and most have broadband internet access.

Credit: Upon successful completion, eight credits are awarded for the internship and four credits for each course. The summer program is worth eight credits total.

What's included in EPA fees: Airport pickup from Heathrow, comprehensive orientation, rent and utilities, two academic courses (one during the summer), internship placement with ongoing support, and 24/7 emergency contact.

Passport/Visa: A valid passport and a United Kingdom Tier 4 Student Visa are required to participate. An FBI background check is needed for health science, education, and museum placements.
