# La Catalina Natural Language School AGREEMENT & RELEASE FORM

## Summer 2009 Trip to La Manzanilla, Mexico

---

1. The undersigned, whose name and signature appear on this form (and my parent or guardian if I am a minor), a registrant for the 2009 summer trip to La Manzanilla, Mexico, hereby acknowledge that I have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions and the provisions contained in the Release below, including my itinerary description and sections concerning responsibility, refunds and changes in dates, prices and accommodations and acknowledge that they form part of my agreement with La Catalina Natural Language *School* (**School**), including its Officers, Directors, Employees, Trip Chaperon, Leaders and other parties hired by the school (**Agents**).
2. I/my guardian voluntarily consent(s) to participate in all activities provided and/or organized by the **School or its Agents** and I hereby assume all risks of loss and injury that may be incurred, directly or indirectly as a result of my participation in all activities provided and/or organized by the **School or its Agents**.
3. I/my guardian, in the case of a medical emergency, authorize(s) the **School or its Agents** to arrange for professional medical care as specified in the MEDICAL RELEASE form included at the end of this Release Form.
4. I understand that the **School or its Agents** shall distribute to me written behavior guidelines and regulations concerning my behavior while traveling. I understand that the **School or its Agents** cannot accept responsibility for travelers not following these rules and regulations, and that I may be sent home at my own expense without benefit of any refund if I do not adhere to the **School or its Agents** behavior guidelines, standards and instructions. I understand that if the **School or its Agents** or civic authorities discipline me, I may not be eligible to continue participating in this trip.
5. I will indemnify the **School or its Agents** and hold them harmless for any financial liability or obligation which I personally incur, or injury or damage to the person or property of others which I cause or contribute to cause, while participating on this summer program.
6. I understand it is my/my guardians' responsibility to inform the **School Directors** or **Chaperon** of any special requirements for me.
7. I understand that the **School or its Agents** reserve the right to assign alternate sessions and reassign participants to a replacement host family should the original accommodation not be appropriate.
8. I understand that their tariffs and/or the Warsaw Convention limit the air carriers' liability for loss or damage to baggage, or for death or injury to person or property, and related

agreements. Further, I understand that the air carriers assume no responsibility during such a time that I am not on board their aircraft.

9. I understand that I am responsible for exercising caution and common sense at all times to avoid injuries. I understand that the **School or its Agents** is providing, as part of the trip fee, basic protection coverage with a travel insurance company for my benefit, including limited health and accident insurance in the event of injury or illness while on this summer program. I acknowledge that I accept the full description and limitation of this coverage that appears in the protection document, a copy of which is available upon request.

10. I hereby waive and release the **School or its Agents**, and my local school, including any person or entity employed or utilized by the **School or its Agents** or my local school, from any claims arising from any injury, loss, damage, accident delay, or expense resulting from events beyond their control, including without limitations, natural disasters, war, terrorism, strikes, incidents of politically motivated violence, sickness or quarantine, government restrictions or regulations, and, in the absence of its own gross negligence arising from the use of any vehicle, or from any act or omission by, any host family, bus, or car rental agency, steamship, airline, railroad, taxi or tour service, hotel service, hotel, restaurant, school, university or other firm, agency, company or individual.

11. I understand that the **School** reserves the right to make changes in the program costs and itinerary description without liability for refund.

12. I understand that obtaining a passport is my responsibility. If I am not a U.S citizen, I understand it is my sole responsibility to obtain, in advance, any visas and other documents, which may be required to enter or connect through all the countries on my itinerary and to re-enter the United States. If I have a passport from a country other the United States, I must contact the local consular office of the countries I will be visiting to obtain the necessary visas. Such visas are not obtainable on the spot over the border or over seas. Whether I am a U,S citizen or not the **School or its Agents** will be held harmless in the event I am unable to obtain the necessary documents for participation in the program. I understand that inability to obtain these visas and other documents do not constitute grounds for withdrawal with full refund.

13. I understand that the **School or its Agents** will provide without charge program cancellation if: 1) The U.S. Department of State states there has been a terrorist attack against the U.S. interests and 2) the U.S. Department of State issues an official Travel Warning that Americans should not travel to any country visited on the itinerary and 3) if an official Travel warning is issued or is in effect two weeks prior to departure. In such situations, if the **School** in its sole judgment decides to operate its program, I may withdraw and I understand that the **School** will issue no refund. In all cases the **School** reserves the right to cancel, alter, relocate or postpone the trip as he/she determine(s) necessary without penalty.

#### 14. TUITION & COSTS

I understand that the weekly costs & tuition of \$950/week does not include airfare or escort services from LAX airport. If I would like the **School** to purchase my child's round trip airfare to and from ZLO and for my child to travel with an escort provide by the **School**, then I understand that there is an additional flat fee of \$890. I further understand that in the event that I/my child chooses to travel to Mexico independent of the group, I/my child am/is

responsible for finding and booking a flight into the Manzanillo ZLO airport on the dates specified and approved by the **School**. Additionally, I understand that the weekly costs & tuition of \$950 does not include the cost of all of the full-day excursions and the overnight tours.

## **TRIP RULES, REGULATIONS & EXPECTED BEHAVIOR CONTRACT**

### **Teen Spanish Immersion Programs**

Welcome to La Catalina Natural Language School! As our premier concern with our Teen Spanish Immersion Programs is the safety and supervision of students participating in the program, we expect that each student respects and abides by the trip rules and regulations established by our school. We feel that with a clear understanding of these behavior guidelines, we will have a successful trip that everyone will enjoy and profit from.

Below you will find our clearly defined rules, regulations and expected behavior, as well as the consequences in the event that any of these rules are not abided by. It will be necessary that both parents and students sit down and review this contract together and sign it.

#### **1. Complete and turn in all necessary paperwork prior to trip departure**

Parents and students will be required to have all paperwork submitted prior to departure date. This includes the following:

- Completed application form with liability release and letter of reference
- Signed Trip Rules, Regulations & Expected Behavior contract

In the event that we do not have all of this documentation, the student will not be permitted to participate in the trip.

#### **2. Display proper behavior on the trip**

Students are expected to display mature, courteous and respectful behavior at all times during the trip. They are to respect the country they are visiting and all the people that they encounter. Students who do not display proper behavior on the trip will be expelled from the school and immediately returned home.

#### **3. Respect all school staff and abide by school rules & regulations**

The Directors or a designated staff member of *La Catalina Natural Language School* will make decisions, choices and rules that they feel are in the best interest of ensuring the student's safety. Students must respect these decisions and follow the guidelines that are set. They must display respectful behavior towards all employees of *La Catalina Natural Language School*.

#### **4. Drug and Alcohol Policy**

Our school has a very strict drug and alcohol free policy that will be enforced by the Directors and Trip Chaperone. In the event that a student violates this policy, he or she will be expelled from the school and immediately sent home. (We have had to do this in the past, so we do take this rule seriously.)

#### **5. Homestay's and Curfew**

During their stay, students are expected to live courteously and respectfully in their host family's house. They must respect their family's rules and the 10pm curfew that is designated by the *La Catalina Natural Language School* unless otherwise extended for special events as authorized by the school. A staff member will have weekly check-ins with all the homestay families to ensure that proper behavior

and rules are being followed. If a problem with a student in a homestay occurs, the student will be required to:

1. Meet with the school Director and homestay family
2. Meet with the Director to discuss disciplinary action

If the problem occurs more than one time, the student will be expelled from the school and immediately return home.

**6. Students Must Attend all Events, Classes, Meetings and Excursions**

It is mandatory that all student show up to their assigned days of Spanish classes, volunteer work, group meetings and travel excursions presented on their itinerary. In the event that a student fails to show up at one of these meetings without contacting the trip chaperone, they will be required to:
