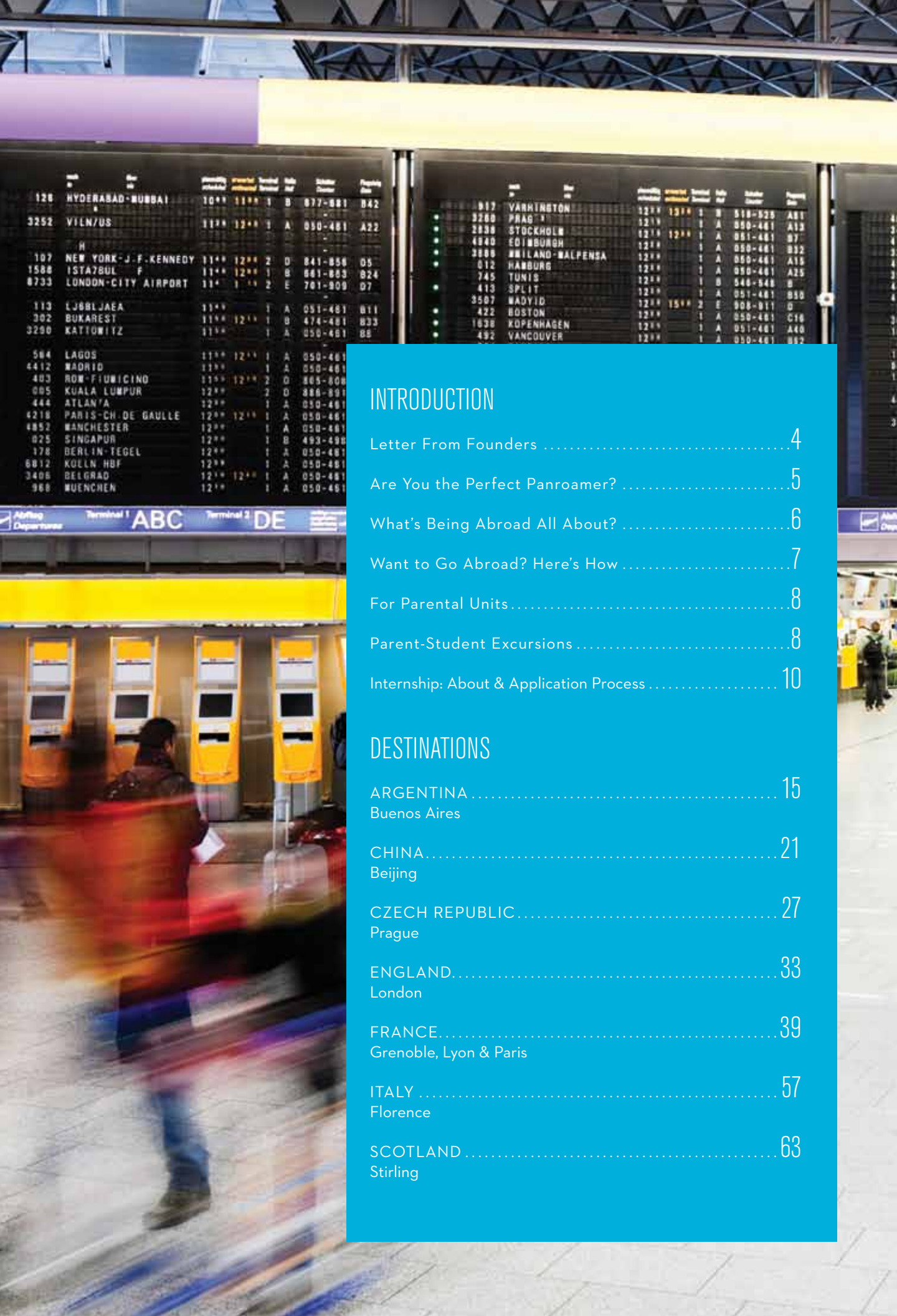
What We Do – Differently

What's Being Abroad All About?

We think a lot of people just assume that you, the student, know what this is all about. That's wrong. Lets break it down, beat by beat.

Studying abroad is studying in a different country for a month, summer, semester or academic year at an accredited university. Interning abroad is using learned theories and skills and applying them to real life work in your field, but in a different country.

Why study or intern abroad? Immersed in a new culture, you'll understand it and its people's habits and quirks; you'll see and appreciate a totally different way of life. Being abroad for a reason, not just for the sake of going, is attractive to future employers and colleagues.

Want to Go Abroad? Here's How.

Step 1: Understand what studying or interning abroad is, and if it's for you. Research online, go to your study abroad office, talk with students who've gone, and know your reasons for going abroad.

Step 2: Decide on your destination and duration. The answer may come to you in a lucid dream.

Step 3: Choose your program. Of course we recommend one of ours if you're a perfect Panroamer. Visit panrimo.com for up-to-date course descriptions, dates, prices, available customized options and application deadlines.

Step 4: Create your profile on Panrimo.com, and register for free. Understand what we're all about.

Step 5: If you haven't yet, speak with your study or internship abroad advisor. If they don't know of Panrimo, have them email us. We'll send a packet of information to them lickitty-split. Now is a good time to chat with your parental units if needed, too.

Step 6: Choose courses at Panrimo.com to take while abroad. Or communicate with a Panrimo advisor to see if they can place you in your preferred internship overseas. Go to your academic advisor to be sure you'll get credit for your studies or work abroad.

Step 10: Get excited to go abroad! Your Panrimo advisor now works with you in securing a visa if needed, where to purchase airfare, suggested packing list, and all the other aspects in preparing to go abroad.

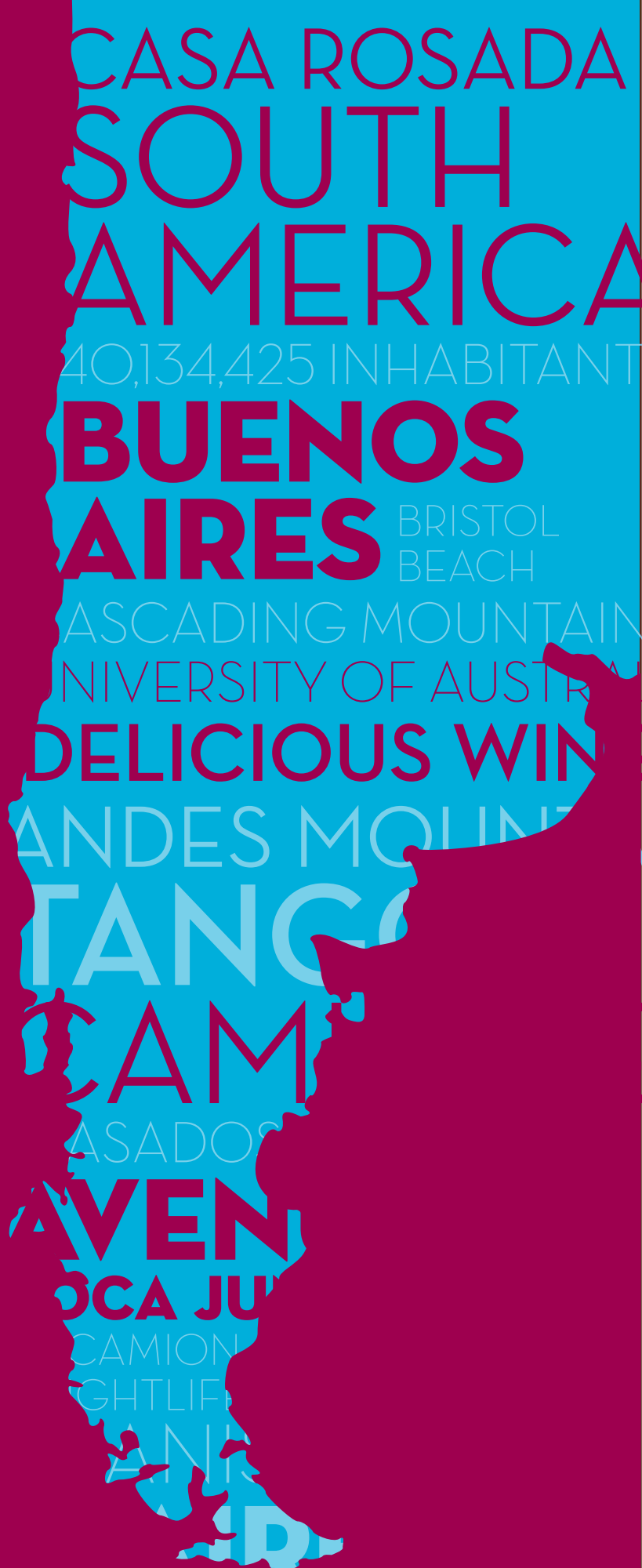

Weekend Out West \$450

Head west to fertile flat lands. Relax in a town of 2900 people; eat asado BBQs, grilled vegetables and tons of flan till you burst. Ride horseback and understand gaucho lifestyle. Roundtrip ground transportation to la pampa region, all meals and asados, lodging with local family, poolside relaxation, impromptu town festivals and your Panrimo coordinator are included on this full three day, two night excursion.

Night of Tango \$100

The best way to understand the seductive nature of Argentines is to watch their bodies move. A night of entertainment and a full stomach await. EXCURSIONS //

Great Wall of China \$150

Built to defend the capital city and imperial tombs, the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall of China is the best-preserved and least frequented section by tourist. We'll walk and travel by cable car to former watchtowers, peering down into dense forests and across valleys. Round trip transportation from Beijing, lunch, entrance fees to the Wall and your Panrimo coordinator are included.

Ming Tombs \$200

What was the Ming Dynasty? Only the most influential power leaders of now-China. Visit the tombs of 13 Ming emperors. An hour trek outside of bustling Beijing, this day excursion includes round trip transportation from city center Beijing, entrance fees to the Ming Tombs, lunch at a local restaurant and your Panrimo coordinator.

TanZhe Temple and Jietai Temple \$200

Not far outside Beijing city center, along roads twisting through mountains, you'll enter yet another world: a world of 300 A.D. China. TanZhe and Jietai Temples are important for their well-preserved halls and pavilions. We'll see these worship sites while resting briefly under a 1,000-year-old ginkgo tree. Then you are off to Jietai Temple, where one was granted status of monk or nun, the highest honor in Buddhism. 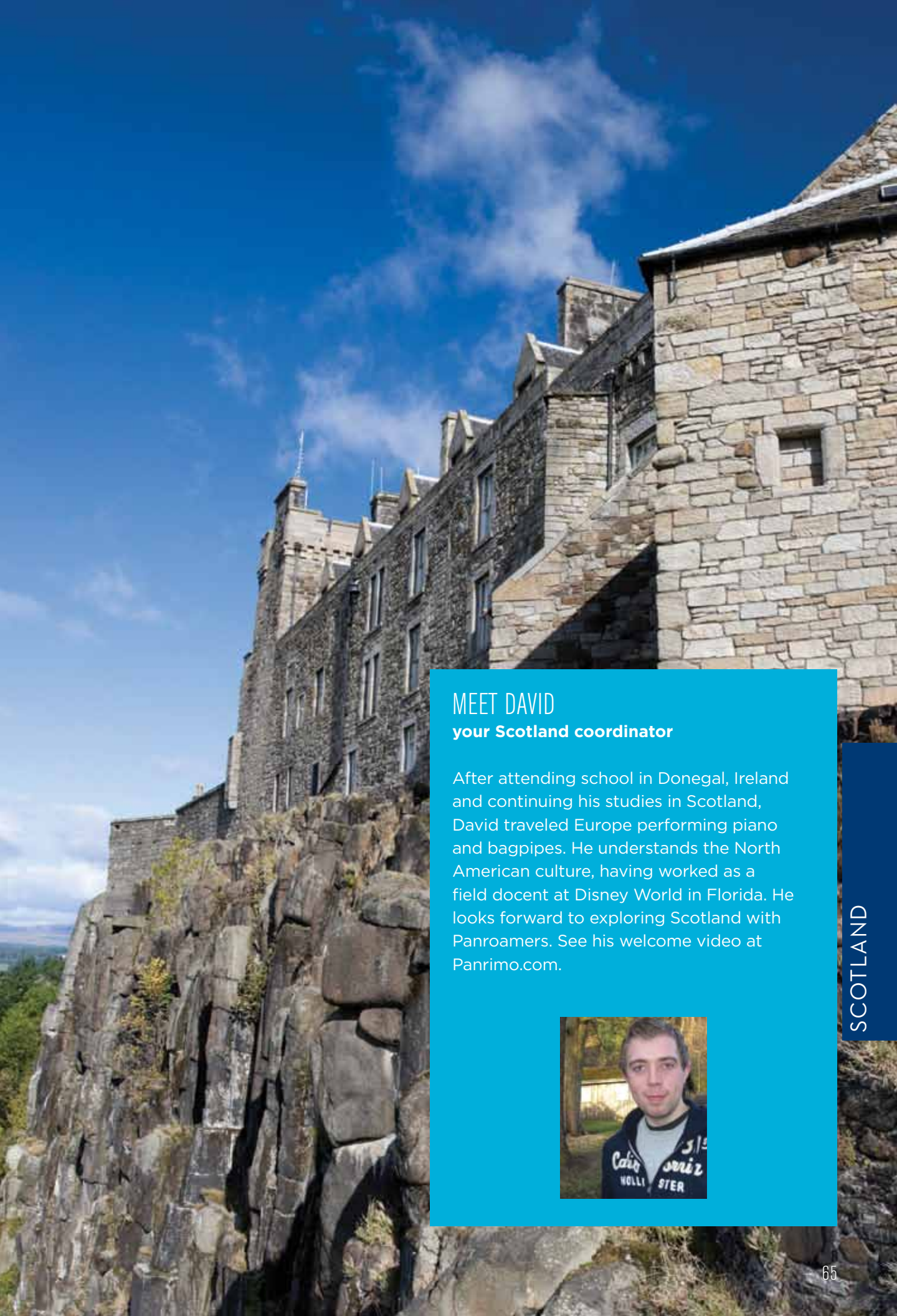

Glasgow \$175

What makes this city, whose coat of arms consists of two wet salmon, interesting? Shopping, theatre, bohemia lifestyles, art, architecture, tearooms, and tenements. Let Panrimo show you the sights for a day, offering a taste of what's available and familiarizing you for a return trip with friends. Included in this day excursion is round trip transportation from Stirling, lunch in a quaint and authentic Glasgow café, city walking tour, your Panrimo coordinator and free time to explore.

Scotch Distillery Tour \$200
