Type of Placements:

The organization offers voluntary work placements to people ranging in age from 18 to past retirement. The type of voluntary work placements includes:

Teaching conversational English – for this no qualifications are required.

Teaching other types of subjects, such as maths, English, music, IT, other languages and various academic subjects.

Conservation projects – there are many of these projects and they differ in type and content according to the location they are based in Tanzania i.e. in Oltmotonyi forestry in Tanzania.

Work Experience placements – these include placements in legal firms, medical institutions, hotels, tourist resorts, journalism institutes etc. and are only offered in Tanzania; they enable volunteers working and studying in a sector to observe and gain experience by working within our project hosts in their field. They are supervised in their workplace and gain real hands on experience.

Cultural Exchange - These are structured courses which are offered to volunteers under the umbrella of our support and back-up system in-country. The Cultural Exchange segment includes courses and interaction in Drama, Music, Art, Photography, Meditation and Bush Survival and other similar.

Language Courses – in the destination country currently in Tanzania where volunteers get –week Swahili lesson.

Care programs- Volunteers gets time to undertake different works to look after babies at different orphanages in Arusha-Tanzania.

SUPPORT

MICATZ has local managers and organisers in Tanzania and in all Destinations that we operate. Without fail, these are highly competent and capable people who are very knowledgeable in the local environment, culture and traditional working practice in Tanzania. They liaise with all local projects hosts to ensure that all placements are suitable and beneficial to the community and to both organisations, as well as to the volunteer. They are on call 24/7 to the volunteers and organisations alike. Volunteers are provided with fully vetted accommodation facilities and are also provided with food.

MICATZ In-Country Support - Our programs all have staff available to help you when you need it, including a 24-hour support team and trained field guides on all projects.

MICATZ Country Information and Orientation - Before you embark on your MICATZ, we provide you with information packages on the country and program in which you will be volunteering.

From the moment you pay your registration fee of US \$200 to MICATZ then will have support 24/7 until the day you finishing your volunteer project.

If a situation changes our local staff overseas constantly monitors the situation. If we think that safety may be compromised, we immediately take steps to remove our participants from the unsafe environment.

Safety can never be totally guarantee whenever we are in the world, MICATZ and its partner organization do all they can do to minimize all the risks. In order to ensure your volunteering project is as safe as humanly possible. You are placed in trustworthy Organization and reliable host family's accommodation situation all of which have been inspected and experience by MICATZ directors.

Volunteer on MICATZ programs often form lifelong friendship with their host families and the people they assist on the volunteer programs. However they also form strong covalent useful bonds with the other volunteers they meet whilst on their placements, work and live together in their placement

Program Fees: At Maasai Challenge, we currently offer the most affordable programs; Please confirm your application with a (Refundable application fee of \$200 USD If you decide **NOT** to go)

To apply, Please follow the following procedures.

(1) Complete the Application Form: Fill out [Our booking form](#). Upon receipt of the form we will assess your suitability for the program within two working days.

(2) Contact You: If you are successful we will then email you a letter of acceptance.

(3) **Decision Point:** Once you have read through the letter of acceptance and we have answered any questions or concerns that you might have, it is time to pay your US \$200 application fee to secure your place on the program.

(4) **Confirmation:** Once the application fee is paid, our volunteer partner or MICATZ will contact you to ensure everything is organized. We will also send you the link to our program guide who covers topics such as country information, travel links, visa application process, fundraising ideas and much more!

(5) **Communication and Support:** Throughout the application process, we are committed to working with you to answer any of your questions or concerns. During your placement we are also available as a form of support to you as a volunteer and will email you.

MICATZ application fees: **US \$200** covers advertising, program promotion, and office expenses (rent, utilities, and staff salaries)

What does your program fee covers?

The total cost includes Registration Fee (Refundable if you choose not to go but the refund can only be done if you will provide us with enough reasons on why you have cancelled your placement) – 24/7 support from MICATZ staff, program marketing costs, information pack, administration costs, travel costs to inspect programs and communication costs with volunteers.

Program Fee – Airport pick up, orientation, program supervision, accommodation and meals during volunteer placement period, In-country 24/7 volunteer support and In-country administration costs.

What program Fee does not cover?

Visa, flights, travel insurance (Compulsory), vaccinations, souvenirs, trips or tours you do while in the country, gift to projects staffs and host family, any personal expenses, transfer back to the airport from program, spending money (volunteers in our different destination generally find US\$40 to be sufficient for basic weekly expenses).
