Placement Examples:

Marine Biology (Earth and Oceanic Science Research Institute): Small vessel use for the collection of biological samples by way of core and grab sampling devices, faunal and floral inventory in series of intertidal surveys, assistance with cephalopod aquaculture, and sorting whale stomach contents for the purpose of dietary determination.

Fashion Design (Bracewell): Dispatch, assisting with sales, assisting with design and production; Organizing marketing initiatives and assisting the lead designers.

Finance (Trust & Fund Services Perpetual): Tasks include daily unit pricing for funds, monthly management of accounts, statutory financial statements, and tax returns.

Marketing (Arts Access Victoria): Keeping the website up-to-date by doing regular uploading of data; this requires good writing skills, formatting and attention to detail; Management of online image library and uploading of images to the website, Coordinating and editing content for the fortnightly eNewsletter, Assisting with PR activities, Managing the organization's Facebook site, Expanding our database of industry contacts - this will largely involve doing online research and filtering information into Excel spreadsheet.
