Community Work with Children in Lake Bunyonyi, Uganda

Fancy a bit of peace and tranquility? Lake Bunyonyi is a water world paradise a million miles from the dust and frenzy of the average African town. The lake itself is set in a beautiful location, surrounded on both sides by spectacular terraced mountain slopes and dotted with 29 separate islands. For most of the time it's full of swimmers but once a week it comes alive with a flotilla of canoes carrying traders who've come to sell their wares. Against this picturesque backdrop you will be working with primary school and nursery children, helping to encourage their creativity, improve their English and generally play a positive role in their personal development. We provide TEFL certification when you sign up and as long as you pack your swimwear you'll have everything you'll need to have a fantastic time.
