With an already low world population in decline there are certainly no grey areas in this conservation project, so do your bit and 'panda' to their every need! Based in majestic surroundings at the foot of the Qingling mountains, you'll also have the chance to work with other fascinating species indigenous to China such as the Golden Monkey, Crested Ibis and the sheep-like Takin.

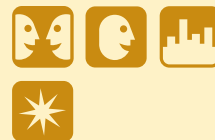


Teaching at Primary Schools in Xi'an

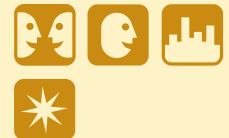
Community work with Special Needs Children around Xi'an

Do you want to teach little people in a big place? It's no surprise that several dynasties made Xi'an their capital, and it's no secret either, with a diverse mix of architecture and design everywhere you look. The city lies in the middle of the country and was perfectly placed for keeping rival groups in the furthest reaches of the country under control. The location is an advantage for you too as it sits halfway between Shanghai and Beijing, making it a good base from which to explore. We work with several projects in the city which look after children with special needs aged between 3 and 19. You will use your free TEFL certification with youngsters who have mental and physical disabilities, providing life-skills training that will hopefully act as a springboard to mainstream education.

Teach English to kindergarten children in Hainan Island, China

Want to teach English in an undiscovered corner of China? You may not have even heard of Hainan Island before now but that's no reason not to visit. Sitting just off the southern tip of China's mainland its sandy beaches are lapped by the South China Sea, making it perfect for relaxing after a busy day of teaching! This project is based in the capital Haikou, whose undeniable charm is a product of palm-trimmed streets, ancient temples, coconut plantations and world class seafood. Your time here will be spent working in a local kindergarten for children aged between 3 and 7 years old. The school runs the bilingual system so children can already speak a little English, but the TEFL certification we include will help polish those skills.

What is TEFL?

If you can speak and write English, then you already have the most important skills you'll need to Teach English as a Foreign Language (TEFL). Once you are fully qualified (which can take as little as two days with our weekend courses), you'll be in a position to find well paid teaching work worldwide.
