Argentina is a land of spectacular contrasts: in the far south lie the frozen landscapes of Patagonia and Tierra del Fuego while in the far north the world-famous Iguazu Falls bask in the heat of the tropics. This diversity makes it a great place for outdoor sports with everything from mountain climbing and skiing to white-water rafting. If it's culture rather than adrenalin that gets your pulse racing, head for Argentina's incomparable

capital, Buenos Aires: the spiritual home of the tango and one of the greatest cities in the Americas.

Argentina is widely regarded as the hottest destination in South America right now. It is safe, easy to get around and pretty cheap which means that no matter how wild your plans, they will be both achievable and affordable.

Why Argentina needs volunteers

Recent economic problems have left Argentina afflicted by the crippling poverty that affects much of South America. When poverty hits it is usually children and wildlife that bear the brunt, and it is no different here. International volunteers are needed at community and conservation projects in both Buenos Aires and the provinces of the north. i-to-i volunteers have already made a huge difference in Argentina and we're hoping you can carry on the good work.

Animal rehabilitation work in Posadas, Argentina

Want to work with animals? Argentina may not be the first country that springs to mind when you think of South American wildlife havens, but it actually boasts larger natural contrasts than any of its neighbours; the frozen landscapes of Patagonia to the south and tropical northern heat create a perfect recipe for a diverse natural world. El Puma Ecological Park in Argentina's laid back provincial capital brings you face to face with the results as it nurses sick and injured animals back to health before releasing them back in to the wild. The project also runs a breeding programme to increase animal numbers so there's a lot to keep you busy, before you head off to discover the rest of the continent's hottest destination.

Besides, as they're Argentinean they'll probably be able to teach you all you need to know on the football field anyway!
