Included Services in ELEBAIRES' Internship Program

- Program of Professional Internship in the required area.
- Spanish Level Exam (on line test)
- ELEBAIRES will give you necessary information to involve yourself in the city with everything that you will need to know in order to live in Argentina. (Pre arrival package).
 - Orientation class and welcome meeting (Welcome Package)

Duration and dates

The Program of Professional Internships will start every Monday, except for Public holidays; in that case you will start the next weekday.

The first day in Argentina you will have your orientation at ELEBAIRES, then a meeting with the company or professional whom will be in charge of your professional internship, during this time you can get to know the Buenos Aires city.

We require an intermediate level of Spanish, after your on line exam we will give you the program you should join once in Buenos Aires. You will take our accelerated classes of two weeks in order to 'refresh' your knowledge and vocabulary, and if you want you can take a month's course at the same time of your professional internship, we also provide individual lessons where you are only taught technical language of the profession in which you will specialize. It will be a great help to understand and enrich your daily vocabulary that your internship will demand you to know.

The duration of the Program of Professional Internships will be a minimum of one month and maximum of six months.

You must realize that the duration of the Program of Professional Internships will depend on your working hours. We recommend our students to work between 4 and 6 hours per day in order to have some time to experience the city and its life too.

Once we have received your subscription at least a month prior to the start of your internship, we will know your profile and can locate you in a company adequate to your needs, we will also need to reserve you a place until the moment of your arrival.

Requirements

- ELEBAIRES´ Subscription Package to the Program of Professional Internship (One month before arrival: Internship fee payment and technical file sent).
- Intermediate level of the Spanish language
- Up-to-date passport and its copy
- Letter of Reference from your University (for Students)
- Degree certificate and Resume or CV (for Graduated Students and Professionals)

- Medical insurance for travelers that protects you during your stay in Argentina provided by ELEBAIRES.

Recommendations

If you really want to make the best of this opportunity you will seriously face a job in Buenos Aires. Although ELEBAIRES has been working for you before, upon arrival it will be your challenge and your responsibility to succeed. We will be behind you all the time but it's your choice to take and advantage of this experience.

Some recommendations:

- Punctuality
- Don't wait for the others, ask anything you need to know.
- Offer your help and knowledge at any time.
- Show yourself as a very self-confident person and dressed as well (In Argentina people is paying attention to the body language and clothing. Here is not a good impression to be so informal or for women to dress very sexy.)
- Choose the most appropriate clothing before arrival. It's not well seen for men to go in shorts, and for women to wear short skirts or very open shirts – like the ones which show your stomach).
- Try to get in touch with the job vocabulary and partners as soon as possible; it will give you a lot of information giving a quick glimpse of the job atmosphere.
- Be polite with everyone, you will need them some time if you are in a hurry.
- Try to speak Spanish as much as possible showing your interest of the language and ask them to do it too.
- If you don't understand something your partners told you, ask them to repeat it again as many times as you need. They will be so helpful.
