Internship Structure

Duration: 2 – 6 months (full-time)

Selection Criteria:

- Students from any study areas who demonstrate their specific internship objectives and goals
- Junior/Senior standing with a min. GPA of 3.0 (B)
- Some spoken & written German language preferred
- Some practical experience (e.g. -summer employment, prior internship, etc.) in the desired internship field

Compensation:

Internships which are 2 months or shorter are unpaid.

Internships which are 3 months or longer depend on the company's compensation policies.

College Credits:

CEPA Europe does not grant any credits or degrees for the internship program. However, credits may be awarded by the student's home institution (as arranged by the home university).

How to apply:

Applications are accepted all year round with a minimum lead time of 3 months prior to the starting date of the internship. **No application fee required!** Visit our website for more information.
