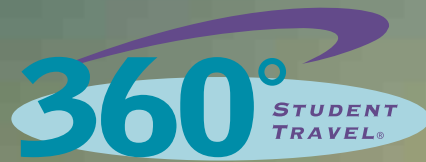

We work with incredible organizations and truly make a difference, while managing to catch a little sun, enjoy two incredible campuses and have a great time along the way!



LOS ANGELES

SERVICE

The Boys and Girls Clubs of Santa Monica open their facilities for recreational activities to help children as they grow. Our group has led activities in all five areas of the club: technology center, arts and crafts, gym, learning center, and games room. This was especially rewarding as we developed close relationships with the children at the club. We were quickly sharing lots of hugs and high fives!

The Orange County Rescue Mission runs The Village of Hope, a transitional housing program designed for homeless men, women and children. There is a strict screening process so all residents share a serious commitment to getting their lives back on track. Our groups have led various types of projects: from hosting a July 4th BBQ and camp activities for children, to running a food drive at a local grocery store and sorting donations in their warehouse.

SERVICE

Habitat for Humanity (HFH) has built more than 300,000 houses worldwide, providing more than 1.5 million people with affordable shelter. We worked with San Diego HFH alongside the families that end up living in these homes! They rely on dedicated volunteers like us so whether we are landscaping, painting or putting up walls, these days will be incredibly rewarding. We also volunteered a day at ReStore, HFH's thrift shop that sells furnishings and building material to provide additional funding for HFH.

The San Diego Food Bank is critical to providing food to people in need. They annually distribute 10 million pounds of donated food to local individuals, families and non-profits that work to alleviate hunger. Last summer, we enjoyed helping to feed 800 people in one morning and packing food boxes.

The Loma Linda Ronald McDonald House (RMH) provides a home away from home for sick children who require treatments at nearby hospitals. 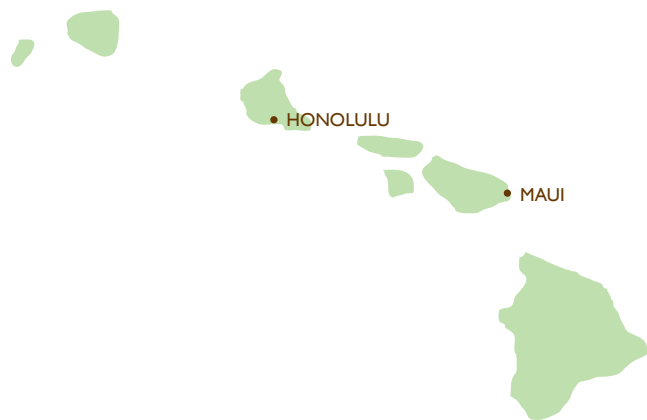

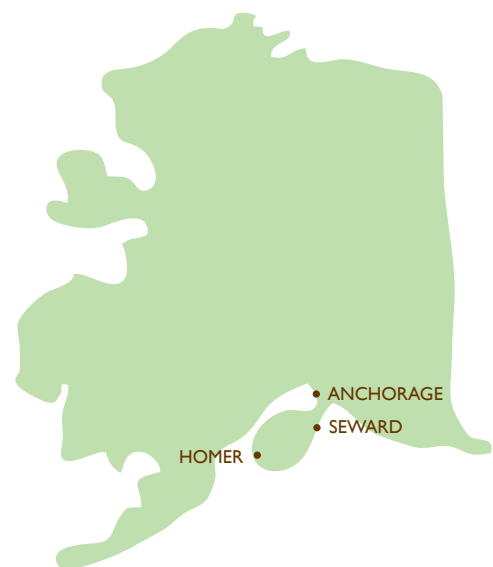

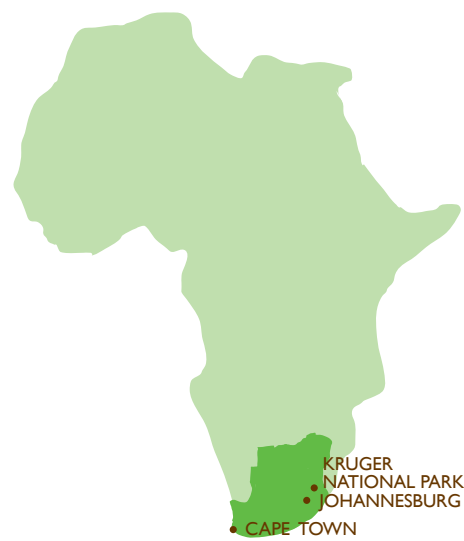

SOUTH AFRICA

SERVICE

Sihlekisi Primary School between the village of Acornhoek and Kruger National Park is the only primary school in this rural area for the children of the Sigagule community and is crowded with 35 kids per teacher. The government provides limited funds. While English is taught, the students rarely have the chance to practice with visitors. We fortunately provide the school with things that are truly of lasting benefit to the community and have formed close ties so that they look forward to our return.

We have planted fruit trees and vegetable gardens, painted classrooms, and most recently helped create the school's first library. Most of all, we look forward to being with the children again, enjoying cultural exchange with games, sports, language lessons where we learn a few words from their Tsonga dialect, while we help them practice their English! The bonds created with the children will leave you with both smiles and tears!

ADVENTURE

Our adventure begins with an orientation to Africa as well as to one another by whitewater rafting the Sabie River. Visit the Apartheid Museum and take a tour of Soccer City – one of the stadiums of the 2010 FIFA World Cup.

Heard of the Big 5? Scout with bush trackers for elephants, leopards, rhinos, cape buffalo and lions on an exciting safari drive in Kruger National Park, home to South Africa's most varied wildlife. We will be working in the two nearby villages of Ezwenelisha and Khula, where we have the opportunity to run a holiday camp for the children and orphans in the community. We will play soccer and games, run arts and crafts activities and help these amazing kids practice their English, all while learning about each other's cultures. These communities need our help to work on projects to construct fences to protect the crèches and the surrounding land, to build a playground or even start construction on a new crèche!

Get to know some of the local customs and learn a few words in Zulu as we partake in an interactive Zulu Cultural Evening. Take an evening game drive in the Hluhluwe-Umfolozi Game Park in search of more wildlife. Travel to Durban, on the Indian Ocean, and enjoy the day swimming and exploring the coast!

SIMON'S TOWN

SERVICE

In contrast to the rural communities we have worked with until now, here we experience the urban poverty of Red Hill or Masi Pamolilailai and lend a hand where our help is desperately needed. In these townships, multiple families share a water source and are unable to build any permanent structures on the land, thus leaving them in poor living conditions. We will either work with crèches, run programs at a library or participate in a building project. Our participants will help teach the children English by singing songs and playing games in these informal settlements to support the families and communities.

At Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope, we experience spectacular views from some of the southernmost tips of South Africa. Stop off at the Cape Point Ostrich Farm before exploring Boulders Beach and the colony of African penguins which call this bay home. 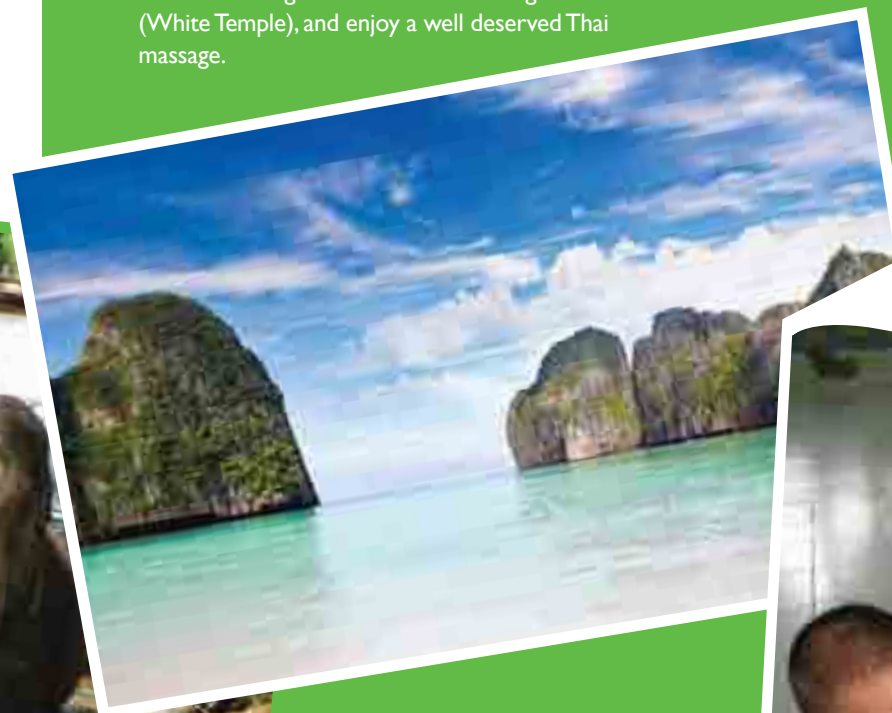
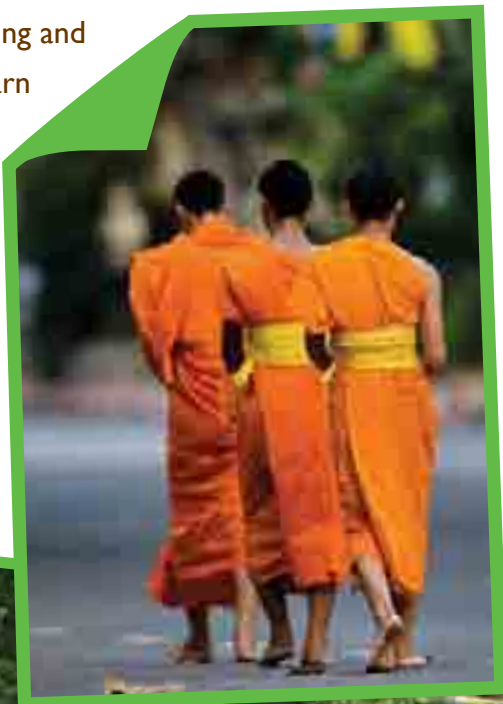

The Chiang Rai Special School is devoted to providing housing and education for more than 400 children from northern Thailand living with autism and mental disabilities. We help to beautify their classrooms or dorms by painting and designing murals or building a playground. We bring many smiles and establish special connections with the students as we stage our own Fun Fair and Mini Olympics. You will surely be enriched.

ADVENTURE

Take a long tail boat through the countryside to Ban Ruammitt, a hill tribe elephant camp where we'll embark on an elephant ride through the countryside and rice fields. In Chiang Rai city, we visit the Night Bazaar and Wat Rong Khun (White Temple), and enjoy a well deserved Thai massage.

THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE

SERVICE

Assist in a fascinating behavioral study on elephants by collecting data, helping with intelligence experiments and getting up-close and personal with them. Working with your own mahout (trainer) you will learn to feed, bathe, and care for your elephant.

Learn how to cook traditional dishes and of course, enjoy the feast at our very own Thai cooking school.

KRABI

SERVICE

Venture down small rivers and tributaries to learn firsthand about the mangroves - trees that line the coastal areas of Thailand. We join the increasing efforts to clean up and plant mangroves to help sustain this important ecosystem.

Koroipita has been able to eliminate unbearable living conditions for low income earners who have in the past been homeless by building "model townships" with the benefit of dedicated volunteers to build the homes that will change resident's lives forever. Our 3 days there will allow us to make a significant contribution.

BOUNTY ISLAND, MAMANUCA ISLANDS

Led by our Marine biologist, we will participate in preserving the reef by farming and coral planting as was seen on the popular TV show The Amazing Race. We will clean the reef, remove its predators and learn techniques to determine the health of the reef. We will also paint or maintain the home as needed. Their smiles and expressions of gratitude will be a valuable parting gift that we cherish.

THE CORAL COAST FINALE

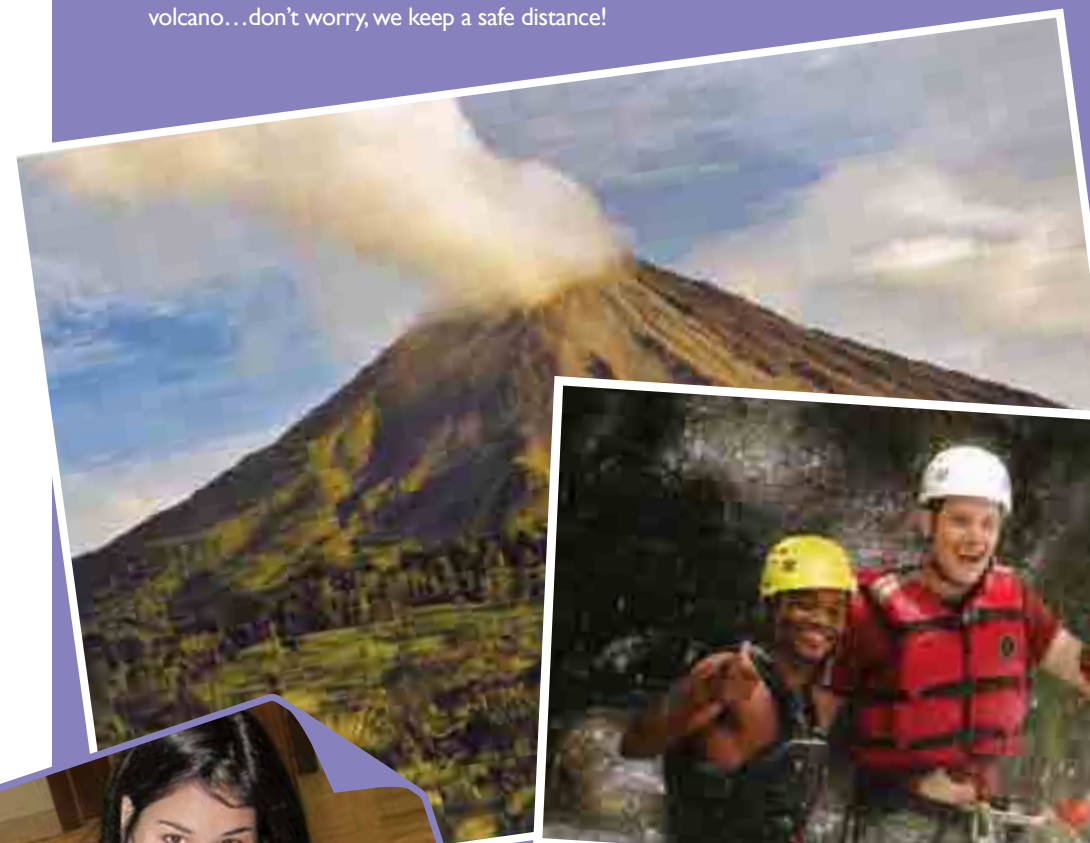

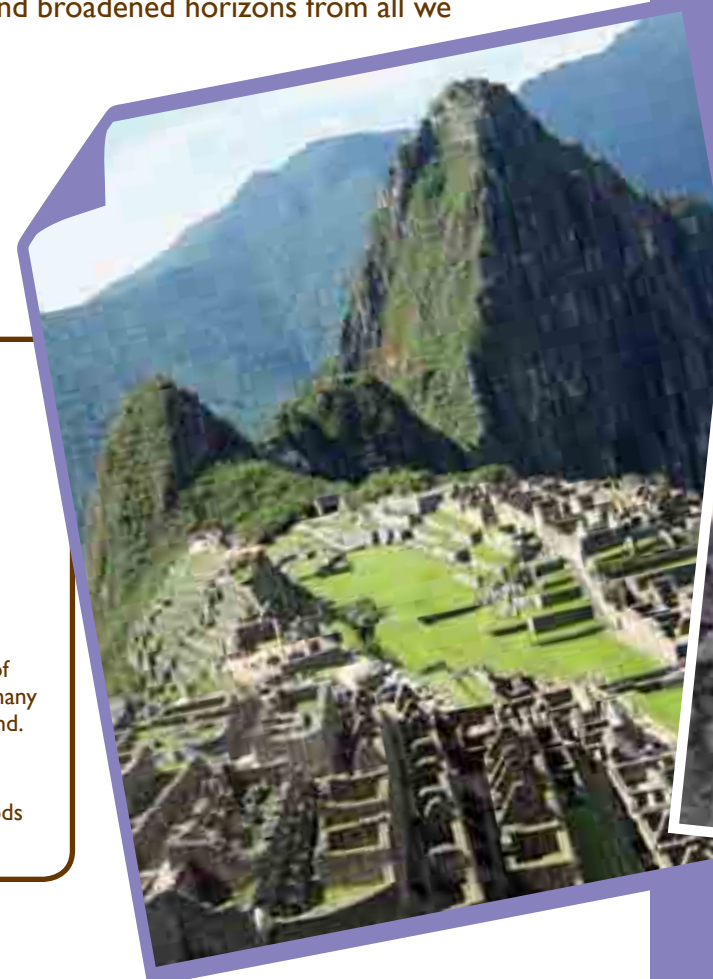

YOUR CURRICULUM

MORNING CLASSES

Spanish Language course (beginner through advanced) meets for 14 sessions (28 day), 13 sessions (21 day) from 10:00am to 1:00pm including breaks.
