## Elephant conservation

£595 for 2 weeks,  
£100 for every week thereafter

Feeding, washing, medical treatment and more with elephants.

---

Become involved in a variety of activities with elephants. This is not the zoo, you will be right there with the elephants, feeding, bathing, and playing with these amazing creatures!

### What is included:

- Airport transfer (to & from)
- Accommodation on site
- 3 meals a day
- 24h in-country support
- Orientation

### Quick overview:

- Project days: Monday to Friday – 3 to 4 hours a day
- Project activities: Working with elephants including helping with feeding, bathing, facilities maintenance, eco farming, raising awareness and much more
- Project location: Kegalle near the Hill Countries
- Open to: Age 18 and above



## Working with orphans

£395 for 2 weeks,  
£75 for every week thereafter

Bring happiness & joy. Orphans in Sri Lanka welcome you.

Become involved in a variety of activities and help orphaned children flourish. Have fun playing games, singing songs, indulging in arts & drama, teaching English and more.

### What is included:

- Airport transfer (to & from)
- Home stay at a local family
- 3 meals a day
- 24h in-country support
- Orientation

### Quick overview:

- Project days: Monday to Friday – 4 to 8 hours a day (flexible)
- Project activities: Working with children; enjoy games, sports, drama, singing, dancing, homework assistance and teaching English
- Project location: Colombo or Kurunegala
- Open to: Age 18 and above



## Sea turtle conservation

£495 for 2 weeks,  
£100 for every week thereafter

---

Find eggs, watch turtles hatch, hand-rear & release into the sea.

---

Search the beach for eggs in the night and morning, collect and bury them in the hatchery. When the baby turtles are born feed them and release them into the deep blue ocean. Be part of this miracle!

### What is included:

- Airport transfer (to & from)
- Accommodation on site
- Breakfast & dinner
- 24h in-country support
- Orientation

### Quick overview:

- Project days: Monday to Friday – 8 hours a day (flexible)
- Project activities: Collect turtle eggs (night & mornings), count them and bury them. Count hatchlings, feed them and release them into the ocean. Help keeping the turtle tanks and the beach clean. You are free to get involved in local community projects around the turtle hatchery as well.
- Project location: Kosgoda on Sri Lanka's beautiful west coast
- Open to: Age 18 and above



## Teaching

£75 for every week thereafter

Teach English and provide children with better chances.

---

Go to Sri Lanka and teach English and/or help with music, drama, arts, sports coaching and more. No need to be an expert, just feel the passion of working with children and transferring your knowledge

### What is included:

- Airport transfer (to & from)
- Home stay at a local family
- 3 meals a day
- 24h in-country support
- Orientation

### Quick overview:

- Project days: Monday to Friday – 8 hours a day (flexible)
- Project activities: Teach English and/or drama, arts, sports and music to schoolchildren (and sometimes adults)
- Project location: Colombo or Kurunegala
- Open to: Age 18 and above



## 2nd chance for disabled

£395 for 2 weeks,  
£75 for every week thereafter

### Help physically disabled youth become self sufficient

---

Work with physically disabled youth (14-25); enjoy teaching, games, sports, dancing, drama, singing, gardening, farming and more.

Help with or lead physiotherapeutic rehabilitation training, so they can become fully self-reliant.

#### What is included:

- Airport transfer (to & from)
- Home stay at a local family or at the boarding school
- 3 meals a day
- 24h in-country support
- Orientation

#### Quick overview:

- Project days: Monday to Friday – 8 hours a day (flexible)
- Project activities: Physiotherapeutic training, teaching English, sports, drama, arts, farming and more
- Project location: Ibbawala (near Weligama / Galle)
- Open to: Age 18 and above
