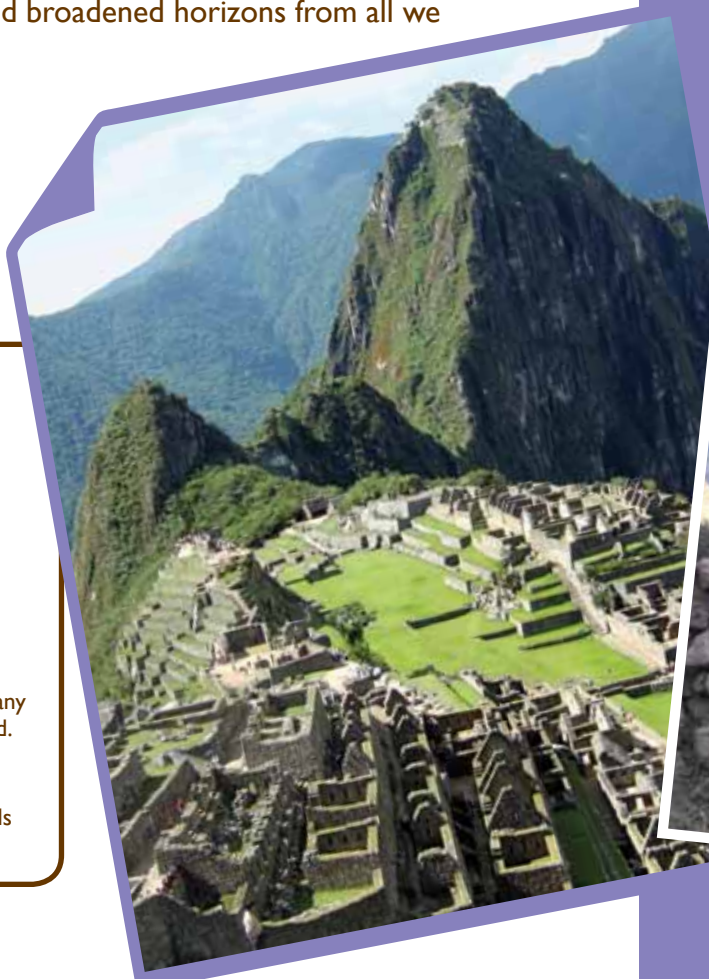
Specific projects are confirmed in late spring and are similar to those described.

AMAZON JUNGLE LODGE

SERVICE

Awake to amazing sights and sounds of the Amazon during your incredible stay in the largest ecosystem in the world. In past years, we helped locals promote awareness and education of this valued ecosystem by maintaining trails, constructing a platform and making signs for the AMTUSET eco-lodge.

Help rehabilitate jungle animals by building additional homes and preparing food for them at a shelter in Puerto Maldonado.

ADVENTURE

Build a balsa raft and float on the Tambopata River to spot exotic wildlife such as giant otters, monkeys and toucans. Follow your tribal guide on a 'Night Creature' walk and gather beads to create local crafts.

CUSCO - ANCIENT INCA CAPITAL

SERVICE

Bring cheer to the children of a local orphanage. In past years, we painted a classroom and dorm rooms, and interacted with and played with the children while establishing a special connection sure to be remembered for a lifetime. Learn the skill of dyeing and weaving wool, and farming or herding sheep in a local village.

ADVENTURE

Whitewater raft the Urubamba River, tour narrow cobblestone streets and explore this ancient Inca capital.

AQUAS CALIENTES GATEWAY TO MACHU PICCHU

ADVENTURE

Travel by train to the Incan ruins and UNESCO World Heritage site of Machu Picchu – surely Peru's most important attraction and one that is likely to leave you breathless. Contemplate this wonder and relax in the hot springs.

SACRED VALLEY

SERVICE

In the mountains of the Sacred Valley, Pisac is a pretty Andean village known for its handicrafts and marketplace, and is our base for community work in the village of Chumbe. Learn the ancient technique and build adobe bricks from mud to be used for homes in this village.

PUNO, LAKE TITICACA, UROS FLOATING ISLANDS

SERVICE

Lake Titicaca is one of the highest altitude lakes in the world. Kayak near the floating islands of Uros constructed entirely of reeds by local islanders. Join the community to preserve these treasured man-made wonders and learn how they live, prepare meals and farm while living in the middle of the lake.

AREQUIPA

SERVICE

Surrounded by snowcapped volcanoes, Arequipa is Peru's second largest city and is known for its glistening white buildings, thus its nickname 'La Ciudad Blanca'. Visit the Las Hermanitas de Los Ancianos Desamparados senior home and bring cheer to the residents who share their culture and life stories. Last year, we danced with the seniors, played games, read newspapers to them and socialized. We served lunch and our group put on a performance that was enthusiastically received.

ADVENTURE

Enjoy lively pedestrian street markets, stylish boutiques, nightlife and an upbeat pulse of city life that best shows modern Peru.

HUACACHINA SAND DUNES

ADVENTURE

Huacachina and its picturesque lagoon is a small oasis where we can paddle boat and try the thrill of sand boarding and dune buggy rides on the towering dunes.

LIMA

Enjoy a farewell stay in the chic Miraflores neighborhood overlooking the Pacific, tour the Catacombs and cherish memories of a beautiful country, warm locals and our new close friendships.
