PARIS – THE CITY OF LIGHTS

Bienvenue! After viewing the city from atop the Eiffel Tower and listening to the chimes at Notre Dame, you will have no trouble remembering why you came to Europe in the first place. Dine in the artist colony of Montmartre and cruise down the River Seine at night. Admire the impressionist collection at the Musée d'Orsay, smile back at Mona Lisa at the Louvre, check out the moderns at the Centre Pompidou, discover Rodin's The Thinker, browse along the Champs Élysées, and take in the action from the top of the Arc de Triomphe. Marvel at Versailles' majestic palace, Hall of Mirrors and elegant gardens of Louis XIV on your guided visit. After breakfasts of croissants, fresh baguettes at lunch, and crêpes on evening visits to the Latin Quarter, you will leave the City of Lights with a new appreciation of la joie de vivre!

TIGNES – VAL D'ISÈRE

Ski and snowboard in the French Alps site of the '92 Winter Olympics. Choose to rock climb, canoe, swim, mountain bike or hike with gorgeous mountain vistas. Complete your Alpine adventure by sliding on your back or belly off a jumping ramp into the lake at the unique and exciting 'Acroland'.

GENEVA

– CHOCOLATE BY THE LAKE

CINQUE TERRE

– “LA DOLCE VITA”

Enjoy chill time in the quaint fishing villages of “Cinque Terre”, five small, classic Italian towns built into the cliffs, rising from the sea and looking much like they did when first settled in the 17th century. Hike between villages enjoying amazing coastal views and irresistible pesto (this is where it was born!). Italian feasts of pizza, pasta, and parmigiana, our first Mediterranean beach day and Italian nightlife – no wonder they call it “the good life”!

VENICE – CITY OF WATER

Where do you start exploring a unique city of over 100 islands connected by 150 canals and 400 bridges? Wander through Doges Palace, cross the Bridge of Sighs, discover the 700 year old craft of Murano glass blowers, feed pigeons in Piazza San Marco, and float away on your evening gondola tour.

FLORENCE – TUSCANY

Home of the Renaissance, Botticelli, Da Vinci and Michelangelo – wandering the streets reveals many artistic treasures including the famed Duomo. Admire the muscular David at the Accademia, check out masterpieces at the Uffizi, and search and bargain for perfect gifts in the leather markets and jewelry shops lining the Ponte Vecchio. treat – gelato at Vivoli's! Put on your apron for an authentic Italian cooking class – we cook and feast! Celebrate our time in Florence with a night at the multi-floored international Space Electronic disco.

SORRENTO, CAPRI & POSITANO – THE FAMOUS AMALFI COAST

Soak up a street carnival atmosphere in the cliff-side town overlooking the Bay of Naples. Cruise to the Isle of Capri to swim in majestic grottos. Take in Capri's café scene in Piazza Umberto and great nightlife at the hottest club. Enjoy the beautiful beach resort of Positano.

POMPEII – THE FORGOTTEN CITY

Explore ancient ruins of Pompeii buried in volcanic ash when Vesuvius erupted 1900 years ago - these excavated ruins offer a fascinating and unforgettable view of history.

ROME – THE ETERNAL CITY

Imagine gladiators in the Colosseum, people watch at the Spanish Steps, dine in the celebrated Piazza Navona, attend a Roman Toga party, discover the ancient treasures of the Pantheon and Forum, and visit Vatican City and enormous St. Peter's Square. Try to picture Michelangelo painting the famous ceiling of the Sistine Chapel and don't forget the tradition of tossing coins in the Trevi Fountain to guarantee your return!
