



## COACH AND PLAY RUGBY: NEW ZEALAND

Rugby is one of New Zealand biggest sports and you can be part of it. You'll coach and train at a reputable Club in Auckland and also coach children in schools around the city. You'll work with children of all backgrounds, including Maori children and those from the South Pacific islands, amongst others.

### WHO CAN APPLY?

Open to everyone - all nationalities and all ages, from age 18 upwards. You must have a very good knowledge of your sport and lots of enthusiasm!

### THE RUGBY PROJECT IN DETAIL:

#### AT THE RUGBY CLUB:

As a Travellers' Rugby Union coach, you'll work at a Rugby Union club that is conveniently located fairly close to your accommodation in Auckland.

Auckland is home to the Blues Rugby Team which plays in the Super 14. The stadium is located fairly close to your accommodation and if you time your placement to take place during the season, you should try and watch a game.

The club has excellent facilities, including an indoor Astroturf training facility, and a large number of junior teams that you'll have the opportunity to coach. They also have a large number of senior teams including a women's team as well as colts teams (under 19s & under 21s) which you'll have the opportunity to coach, train with and possibly play for if you get selected.

The club we work with play to a high standard in Auckland.

The age ranges we work with include:

- U6's - U13's
- U19's and U21's (Colts)

If you wish to also play Rugby Union on this project, you will have the opportunity to with a number of senior teams. There is a good mixture of standards at the clubs so there is something for everyone. Rugby in Auckland is also divided by weight so if you are under 85 kg you can play in the restricted weight category which tends to be a very fast paced and exciting game to play. The senior teams that you can train with and play for include:

- 2 Men's open weight category teams
- 4 Men's under 85kg category teams
- 2 Colt men's teams (under 19s & under 21s)
- 2 Men's social sides
- 1 Woman's team
- A large number of touch rugby teams in the off season

The club you will be working at has a great social scene - you will soon be embraced into the Kiwi Rugby culture.

As the main Rugby Union project won't occupy all your time, during the daytime you'll work on the School Sports Project. Here you can coach Rugby Union and/or a number of other sports for around 4-5 hours every day, leaving your evenings free to coach and train with the Rugby Union team.

### THE RUGBY SEASON & COACHING TIMES:

The Rugby Union season runs from:

- Seniors Late March - Mid August
- Juniors: Mid April - Mid August

Touch Rugby season runs from:

- Late Oct - Dec & late Jan - End of Feb

Coaching and training times are as follows:

- Juniors: 5:00– 6:00: Tuesday to Thursday
- Seniors & Colts: 6:00 - 8:00 Monday to Thursday

Games take place on the weekends during the season. The juniors play in the morning - you'll have the opportunity to coach the junior team, putting everything you have taught them into practice on the field. In the afternoon it will be your opportunity to play with the seniors. Out of season there will be no opportunity to play cricket at the club.



### AT THE SCHOOL:

The School Sports Project will take place during the day. For this element of your programme, you will be working at a school located in Auckland. You will be working at a school located in Auckland. The school has children from a variety of backgrounds and countries such as Maori children and children from Sudan and Somalia who are refugees, as well as children from other lower economic countries such as Samoa and Tonga. The school has good facilities that will enable you to coach a variety of different sports.

There are a wide number of sports available to coach on this project and you will be involved in a wide range of sporting activities, giving you great diversity. The sports are generally coached by season, but if you wanted to coach a sport that was not in season, or if you wanted to introduce a new sport to the children, the school would welcome it as long as it was of benefit to the children. Each school offers different sports so if there was a particular sport that you were interested in coaching please let us know and we will make arrangements for this.

**This project is only available during term times.**

### The term dates for 2011 are:

Term 1: 3 Feb - 15 April  
 Term 2: 2 May - 15 July  
 Term 3: 1 August - 7 Oct  
 Term 4: 25 Oct - 20 Dec

The lessons you'll teach generally last for 40 minutes and the school day runs from around 8:55am to 3:00pm. You'll assist the sports teacher and you'll spend about 3 to 5 hours a day helping the children at the school.

**DURATION:**

4 weeks up to 1 year, subject to visa requirements. Extra weeks available, just ask your Project Coordinator about extending your stay while on your project.

**POLICE CHECKS:**

Within New Zealand Law it is compulsory for all volunteers who work with children to undergo a police check. These checks are done to ensure the safety of children in New Zealand.

The checks are a simple process and we will provide you with all the details of what identity you need to take with you. On your arrival in Auckland, our New Zealand manager will complete the checks with you and take you through the process. As soon as you have registered, you'll be allowed to start working with children.

The fee for the checks is included in your project price and we will ensure that you have all the relevant information before you come to New Zealand.

**ACCOMMODATION & LOCATION:**

You'll be accommodated in a centrally located lodge that is friendly and relaxing, making it ideal for long-term stays. You may have your own room or you may share a room with other volunteers. There is a communal kitchen and storage area for cooking meals and plenty of space to relax.

Entertainment at your accommodation includes cheap internet access, TV and free pool table. You are a stroll from the Sky Tower, harbour and waterfront. Accommodation is very central and close to the main train station and shopping district. Buses are also only a few minutes away to take you to parts of Auckland and New Zealand or to the many other 'things to do'!



The city centre boasts great shopping, restaurants and pubs or head over to the viaduct for more pubs, nightclubs and multicultural cuisine. You'll get to work via bus, which is close to your accommodation.

The city is modern and vibrant - a fun and friendly with beautiful surrounding islands and harbour. Some of its the famous attractions around Auckland include the sky tower, Rangitoto island, the Hauraki gulf islands and the many extinct volcanoes that provide great views of the city.

Auckland has restaurants to suit all tastes - the most popular cuisine is New Zealand lamb which can be ordered at many restaurants around the city and is well worth it.

For meals in local restaurants, a trip to Auckland's inner city centre is well worth the effort - it bustles with activity and offers a range of choices of restaurants.
